Families will only be permitted to walk their students to class the first week of school. At the 7:45 a.m. bell, families will need to exit the site. Beginning August 19, all students will walk to class on their own.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

- Q: How do we know what classroom/teacher my child is assigned to:
- A: Classroom assignments will be posted on the school website Friday, August 9th after 5:00 p.m.
- Q: Where does my child go in the morning?
- A: All students may participate in our run/walk club, go to the lunch arbor for breakfast, or line up on the blacktop from 7:30 a.m. 7:45 a.m.
- Q: If my child is late (not in class by 7:50 a.m.), where should he/she go?
- A: Your child must sign-in at the office to receive a tardy pass.
- Q: Can I walk my student to class when they are late?
- A: In order to ensure classroom instruction is uninterrupted, late students will need to walk to class on their own.
- Q: Who should I call when my child is sick?
- A: For absences, call the school office no later than 8:30 a.m. (619) 906-2200
- Q: Will my child eat breakfast and lunch at school?
- A: Your child may eat breakfast and lunch at school. School breakfast and lunch are free of charge. Breakfast is served 7:30-7:45 a.m.
- Q: Should I send my child with a snack every day?
- A: Yes, students may have a snack during their morning recess.
- Q: Can I volunteer to help in the class?
- A: We LOVE volunteers! Teachers may ask for volunteers throughout the year. Please be sure to talk with your child's teacher about volunteering. Volunteer applications can be found in the office and <u>must be</u> completed each year.
- Q: Can I be on campus during the school day?
- A: All visitors/volunteers MUST sign in at the front office with a valid driver's license or ID <u>and</u> have current volunteer paperwork on file. All volunteering must be pre-arranged with the teacher or other staff member.
- Q: What do I do if I need to pick up my student early?
- A: Please notify the teacher <u>and</u> the office. Come to the office a few minutes early to allow time for your child to pack up and walk to the office. Your child will not be called to the office until you arrive.
- Q: Will my student need any school supplies?
- A: Students will need a backpack (and lunchbox if they are not eating school lunch). Families are not required to purchase supplies. However, each classroom has a wish list of items to support our site with materials throughout the year. We greatly appreciate all donations.
- Q: Should I label personal items?
- A: Yes. Please mark all backpacks, lunch boxes, coats, etc. with your child's name.
- Q: Does Marvin have before and after school care?
- A: SAY San Diego: Fee based licensed program that offers before and after school care.
