INTRODUCTION

Your text should be in Times New Roman font size 12, single-spaced; do not add spaces before and/or after paragraphs. It is better not to format your text with any particular technique. Instead, leave your text plain unless you need to type certain words in a “special way” or emphasize certain words. Italics are mandatory when typing non-English words. Arabic words are transliterated according to the Interdisciplinary Journal of Islamic Education (IJIE) style, which is available for download in PDF file format.

Please explore the background of your article (the gap between the law in books and the law in practice) and the current position of your research, among other research on the related theme. You should discuss here as well the relationship of your research to the research of other researchers; a literature review, especially of the most relevant and recently published academic works in highly reputable journals, is a must.

To put it another way, please try to answer at least two questions: why you believe that your research question is such an important to answer and how other scholars have

or have not answered, or how you think your answer would be a contribution to the existing scholarship on the subject.

A detailed description of your methods in doing the research is not necessary to write down in this section. However, if you think you have to do so, you may mention it slightly in one paragraph.

A little bit of exploration on the flows of your discussion and the expected final results will be good points for closing this introduction section.

THE FIRST ASPECT OF THE DISCUSSION, AS THE SECOND SECTION

Here you can discuss each aspect of the problem one by one. It is important to build an argument and provide original data that is discussed and compared with other research and academic works. In other words, the way to discuss the problem here is by combining data and discussion. So, it is not advisable to separate the description of the data from its analysis.

Each citation is written in a certain way that can be identified as a "citation" that is different from your original text. At the end of each citation, you must list its reference in the **American Psychological Association (APA) 7th edition style**. References must also be listed at the end of each quotation, which is a paraphrase of ideas from someone else's work. Please provide the full internet URL and the date of access.

THE THIRD ASPECT OF THE DISCUSSION, AND SO ON

It is possible to add sections as needed. A section may consist of several sub-sections, typed in numbered list style, like the following example.

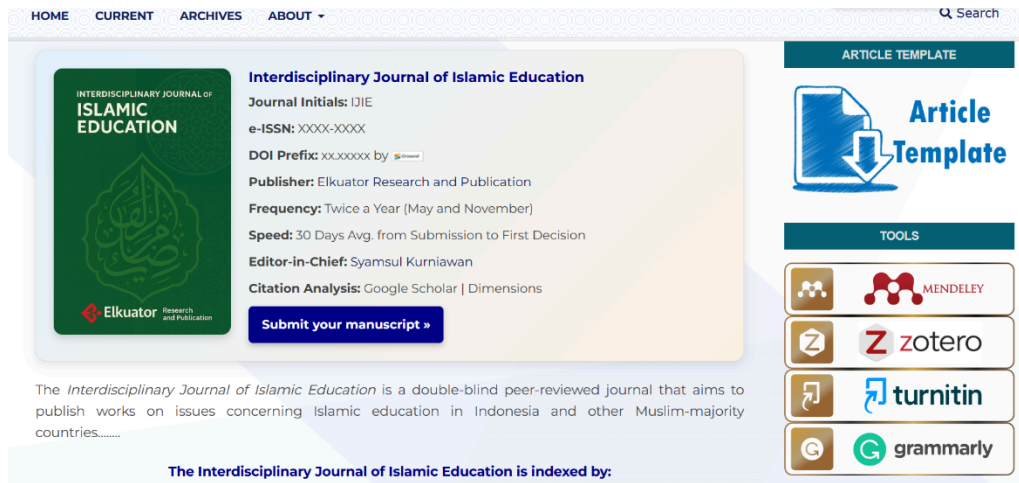
