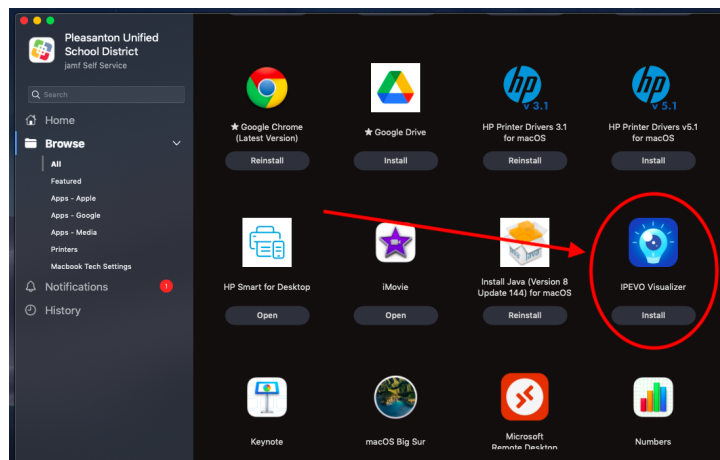
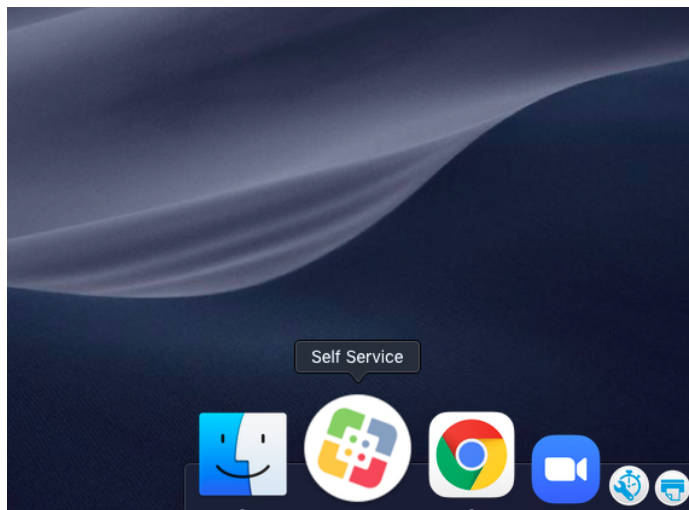


Ipevo Doc Camera

Software

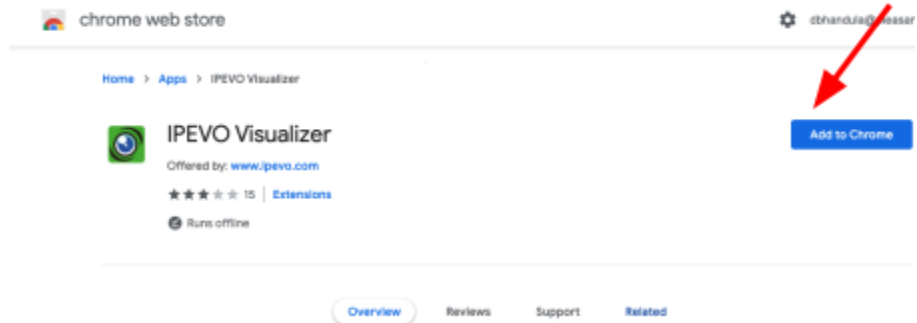
1. The IPEVO Visualizer software is available through **JAMF Self-Service**. This will allow you to install it w/o needing to log into the App Store. In case you get an error while installing, please let me know.



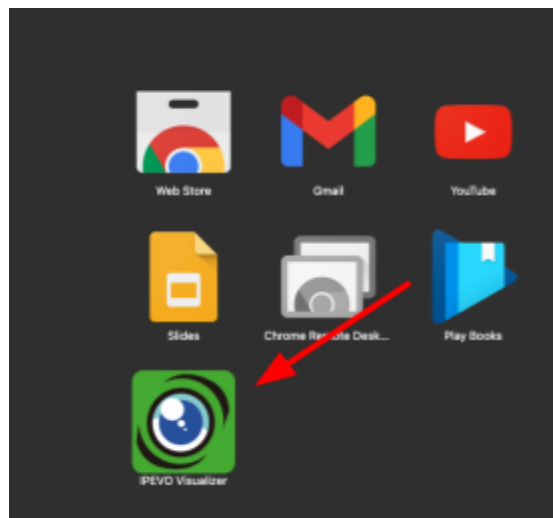
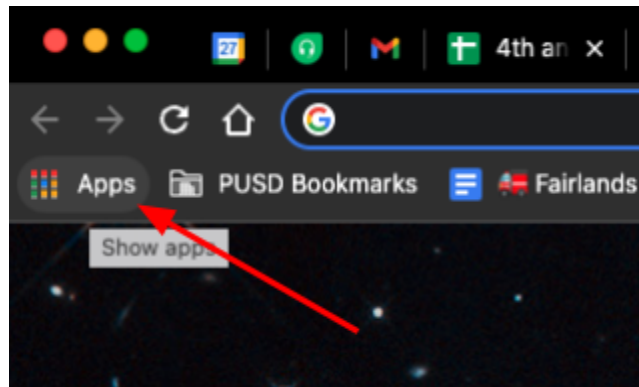
2. Open the app and you are ready to use the Doc cam

1. Click on **Add to Chrome** button



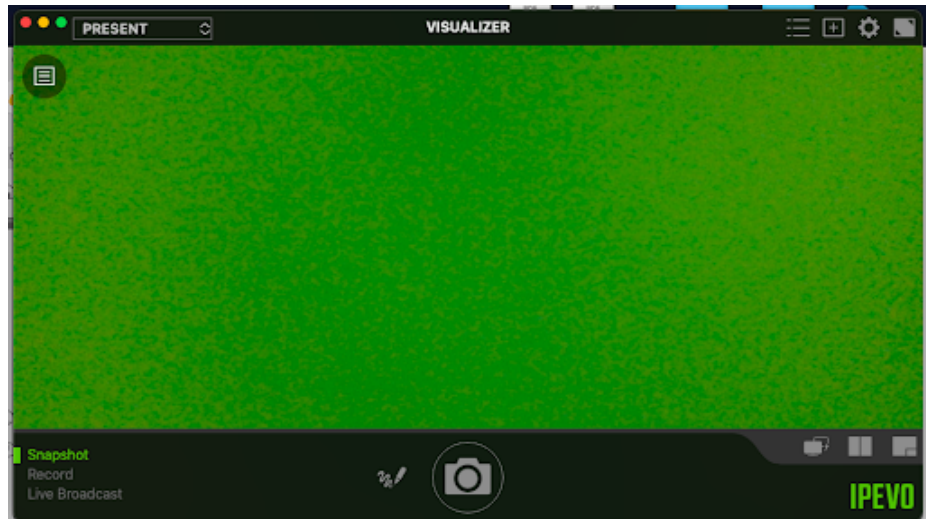
2. Click on Apps Icon on the Chrome Browser and launch the app

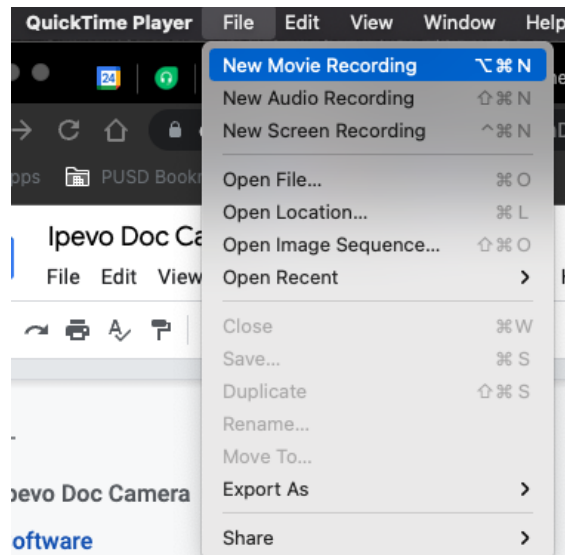

- Direct Usb connection to Viewsonic



- Connect Doc camera directly to Viewsonic via a cable.
 - Please click on the **home** button on the Viewsonic and look for the **Camera** button at the bottom left corner.
 - Select that input source and the document camera will display on the Viewsonic.

- Using QuickTime player
 - Please go to Applications → QuickTime Player
 - Double click to open the application
 - File→ New Movie Recording



- Select the Ipevo Camera from the drop down selection of cameras
