# TED FELLOWS REFUSE TO BE ASSOCIATED WITH GENOCIDE APOLOGISTS January 24, 2024

Dear Chris Anderson,

It's time for us to end our association with TED. There is no doubt that TED changed our lives and has given us life-long friendships, but we are no longer willing to be associated with an organisation that platforms and honours vocal supporters of Israel's genocide of Palestinians. 2024 main stage speaker Bill Ackman has <u>defended Israel's genocide</u> (1)(2) and <u>ethnic cleansing</u> (3) of the Palestinian people and has cynically <u>weaponised antisemitism</u> (4) in his programme to purge American universities of <u>Pro-Palestinian freedom of speech</u> (5). Bari Weiss, also invited as a main stage speaker, has a long, sordid, and well-documented <u>history of anti-Palestinian</u> (6) speech. Like Ackman, she has weaponised antisemitism to <u>defend Israel's genocide in Gaza</u> (7) and has a track record of transphobic extremism (8).

As of today, there are no Palestinian speakers in the line-up, and even if there were, this false sense of balance could not hide the fact that TED has chosen not only to align itself with enablers and supporters of genocide, but to amplify their racist propaganda. This is a shameful position to take, and one that we refuse to accept. We refuse for our work and identities to be exploited to promote the TED brand while the organisation and its speakers generate income and advance their careers through dehumanising Palestinians and justifying their genocide.

TED has a long history of uncritically platforming the US military and arms trade, Israel's most resolute backers. In 2011, TED gave the main stage to General Stanley McChrystal commander of Joint Special Operations Command during the US's horrific, murderous, and duplicitous invasion of Iraq in 2003 (9), and later commander of the indefensible, disastrous, and unconscionably destructive invasion and occupation of Afghanistan (10). In 2012, TED gave a main stage speaking slot to Regina Dugan, former director of DARPA (The Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency) and director of the US armed forces innovation engine which is also deeply implicated in Afghanistan, Iraq, the US's numerous other wars of aggression, and its gruesome role as the world's most prolific weapons dealer (11). The US military and weapons industry are fundamentally complicit (12)(13) in the genocide of Gaza's Palestinians (14). In 2023 TED hosted a stunningly light-touch interview with Elon Musk, a man who publicly espouses and promotes racist (15)(16) and antisemitic theories (17), who voiced his support (18) for Israel's destruction of Gaza in a visit in November 2023, and who promised that without Israeli approval, he would not provide Gaza with internet access through his Starlink network - a service he provided enthusiastically for Ukraine. Rather than admirable and inspirational speakers, we believe a more honest assessment would characterise such quests as facilitators of war crimes.

In this context, we've become increasingly concerned about the fundamental values and moral compass of the organisation over the years, but with this year's speaker selection, it is clear TED has crossed a red line. If the organisation would like to begin repairing its reputation, it should immediately disinvite both Ackman and Weiss from the 2024 conference, and make a

genuine effort to respond to the ongoing genocide by inviting Palestinians themselves to speak of their research, scholarship, and experiences that for decades have clearly documented Israel's apartheid, occupation, ethnic cleansing, and genocide. However, in the unlikely event that this happens, it will be without our participation because we are ending our association with the TED Fellows programme with immediate effect. We are asking TED to remove our names and any references to our work from ted.com and blog.ted.com by January 31, 2024, and to no longer include us in references to the TED Fellows programme. Going forward, we will similarly no longer affiliate with the organisation.
