Context

"Process mapping is the graphical representation with illustrative descriptions of how things get done."

In order to improve or launch an initiative, it's extremely useful to get a sense of the actual process you go through or will need to go through. You can return again and again to your map to conduct process reviews and improvements. You can use this reference to understand how process maps inform initial work in your school or district.

Create an internal Process Map

- Once you have a Graduate Profile in place you will start designing your Capstone process
- This can help you and your team identify how a capstone model fits into your existing school structure and system
- Refer to the <u>Capstone Process Map Slides</u> with your team. This can provide support for the process schools in New Mexico went through to create their Capstone Process Maps.
- Create a Capstone process map of the process your school or district will go through that ends with a capstone demonstration.
