

Birthday Celebration, Make a Wish

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Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets:** Birthday Celebration Photopolymer Stamp Set (164592) or 10% off with dies (164599)
- **Cardstock & Paper:** Pool Party (122924), Basic White Thick (159229), Wildflower Birthday 12" x 12" Specialty Designer Series Paper (164591)
- **Stamp Pad:** Pool Party Classic Stampin' Pad (147107), Old Olive Classic Stampin' Pad (147090), Peach Pie Classic Stampin' Pad (163810), Pretty in Pink Classic Stampin' Pad (163807), Subtles Stampin' Write Markers (161698)
- **Tools:** Birthday Celebration Dies (164598) or 10% off with stamp set (164599), Take Your Pick Tool (144107), Bone Folder (102300), Paper Snips Scissors (103579), Paper Trimmer (152392), Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653), Clear Block D (118485), Clear Block H (118490)
- **Miscellaneous:** Party Dots (164602), Baker's Twine Essentials Pack (155475), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430), Mini Stampin' Dimensionals (144108), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755)



Measurements:

- Pool Party: 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" scored at 4 1/4", folded then burnished with the Bone Folder (card base)
- Wildflower Birthday 12" x 12" Specialty Designer Series Paper, Cake Print: 3 1/4" x 4 1/2"
- Wildflower Birthday 12" x 12" Specialty Designer Series Paper, Stripes (alternate side to Cake Print): 3/4" x 2 1/8"
- Basic White Thick: 3 1/4" x 4 1/2"
- Basic White Thick: 2 1/4" x 3 1/4"
- Basic White Thick: 1 1/2" x 2 1/4"
- Basic White Thick: 4" x 4"
- Bakers Twine: 21 1/2"

Instructions:

1. Adhere 3 1/4" x 4 1/2" piece of DSP, Cake Print side up, to the 3 1/4" x 4 1/2" piece of Basic White cardstock, then attach to the card base using Stampin' Dimensionals.
2. Stamp two Pool Party banners images and two Peach Party images and fussy cut them. Then adhere two Pool Party banner strings together overlapping one banner on the end to create a longer banner string; do the same for the Peach

Pie banner strings. Using Mini Stampin' Dimensionals on about every other banner, attach one banner string to the card front. For the second banner, cross over the first banner and use Dimensionals only on the banner pieces that do not overlap.

3. Die cut tag from the 2 1/4" x 3 1/4" Basic white cardstock and stamp the sentiment using Old Olive ink. Take a Pool Party Stampin' Write Marker and tap above the tag to create flecks of ink.
4. Stamp the sentiment again using Pretty in Pink ink on the 1 1/2" x 2 1/4" piece of Basic White cardstock.
5. Fussy cut "Wish" from the Pretty in Pink sentiment and attach to the tag over the Old Olive "Wish" using mini glue dots.
6. Adhere the 3/4" x 2 1/8" DSP piece, stripe side up, to the tag about 1/4" from the top, wrap white twine around the banner over the DSP and tie a bow.
7. Attach the tag to the card front (over the banner strings) using Stampin' Dimensionals.
8. Attach a few Party Dots.
