Teen Guidelines for Programming

- 1. Teen programmers must be at least in 9th grade.
- 2. Teen programmers **cannot** collect private information from patrons, including but not limited to phone number, email, address, name, age.
- 3. Teen run events cannot raise funds for anything but the library.
- 4. Teen programmers must give 48 hour notice if they will miss a program, barring an emergency.
- 5. Failure to give proper notice or failure to arrive without prior warning will result in a 6 month ban on any future programs. No community service hours after the failure to show will be granted.
- 6. Teen programmers are expected to arrive 15 minutes before their program and will clean up after their program is finished.
- 7. Teen programmers will dress appropriately and follow the general rules of the library, no running, excessive loud noise, inappropriate language or destruction of property.
- 8. Teen programmers will report any concerns or problems to a library staff member immediately.
- 9. The Plainsboro Public Library reserves the right to deny a teen presenter sponsorship and space at any time.
- 10. Teen programmers are required to meet with the librarian before they start their program to go over these rules.
