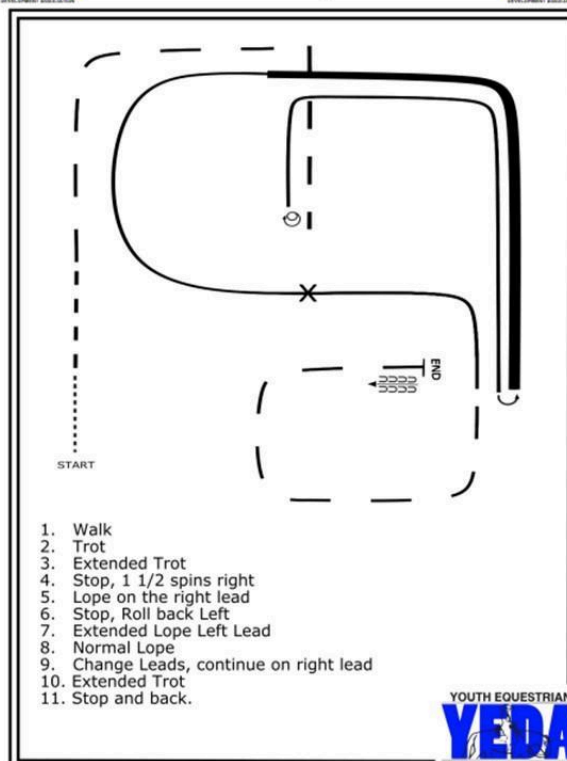
Sapphire/Alumni Pattern 9



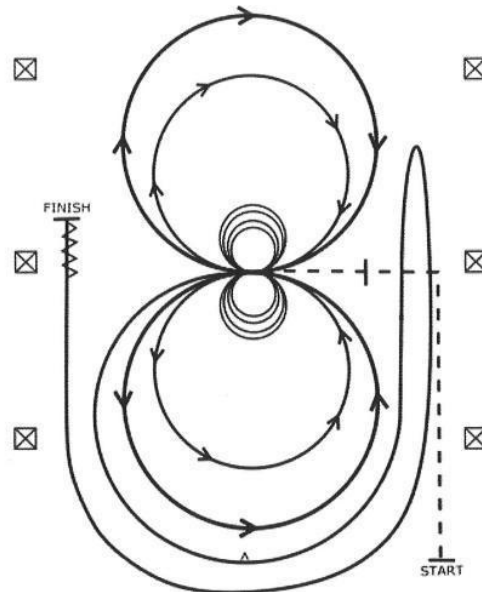
