## Saving Files - Create a Drawing in Paint

You choose File and click Save in order to keep something that is on the screen. When you save, you are saving a file. When saving for the first time, there are **2 important things to do** 1) choose the **location** (where it is saved) and 2) the **name** (what you want to call it).

You only use **Save As** to make a copy of an existing file. This is a useful technique to have a file that has a lot of things you want but you need to make changes while keeping one without the changes.

Follow the steps below to draw and save the drawing (file) using the drawing application **Paint**.

1. Open **Paint** using either method below:

| Start Menu                                   | Search   |

| b. Scroll down and click Windows Accessories | b. Type <b>Paint</b> c. Click the <b>Paint</b> App |
| c. Click on <b>Paint</b>                     | c. Olick the Family App                            |

2. Click the **Brushes** command and click a brush you like.



3. Click the **Size** command and choose a size to draw with.




5. To draw, drag around the white area of the screen to draw anything you like. If you make a mistake try the Undo command to step backward or the eraser tool to paint over the area.



- 7. Now we are ready to Save the file. Click File.
- 8. Click Save

- 9. Click Documents Documents on the left (you may need to scroll up).
- 10. Click in the filename area File name: Untitled and type **Drawing in Paint** for the filename.
- 11. Click Save.



- 13. Click **File** and click **Save**. The changes are saved with the same name and same location.
- 14. Close **Paint** when done.
- 15. To submit your work, return to the **Canvas Introduction to Computers Course** website. Open **Google Chrome** and go to <u>www.canvas.instructure.com</u> and sign in.
- 16. Click **Assignments** on the left and choose the **Saving Files Create a Drawing in Paint** assignment. Click **Submit Assignment**, click **Choose File**, choose the **Documents** folder, and double-click the **Drawing in Paint** file. Click **Submit**.
