Measure D Bond Report / Update	Julie Parks, Superintendent Brett W.McFadden, DAG	The District staff and Brett McFadden presented the District report. The slides are attached. Gian and John Panetta asked about public input and inquired about the number of respondents to the survey (215) and the	

		demographics of the respondents (a mix of staff, community members, parents, business owners, and students). Response rate was average for surveys from the Moraga School District and the survey was promoted in the Moraga School District and on community websites.

Financial Reporting	Sana Ahmed, CBO	Sana Ahmed presented the financials and this is included in the presentation.
		Jack Weir asked about the interest rate and how many years that the taxpayers will have to pay this off. The interest rate is 5% and will be paid by 2044.
		Sameer Pangrekar asked about contingencies. Brett McFadden shared that contingency is factored into the Facilities Master Plan and will be incorporated into specific projects (both contingency and soft costs). The law will allow the District to retain certain amounts if there is any dispute upon completion.
		\$175,000 issuance costs were an expense after the issuance of the bond. The District has procured software, Colbi, for bond tracking (\$5,000). We have a consulting expense for Urban Futures (\$100,000). There are some legal fees also included (\$10,000). The bond rating analysis (\$25,000) is also included.
		At Rheem a new Bogen Unit has

		been installed. This is a safety communications upgrade. More itemized expenses were requested at a future meeting.
Member Comments	All Members	In the next meeting, we will need to begin with appointing the chair and vice chair for the CBOC and determining committee assignments. A recommendation was made to propose the project list with the aligning bond language.
