Mark Scheme for Essays:

Paper 2: Writing - Essays on texts and films will be assessed according to the following assessment criteria.

AO3 (20 marks)

17 – 20 The language produced is mainly accurate, consistently secure grasp of grammar, wide range of vocabulary appropriate to the context and the task.

13 – 16 The language produced is generally accurate, some minor errors. Generally good grasp of grammar with a good range of vocabulary appropriate to the context and the task.

9 – 12 The language produced is reasonably accurate, but there are a few serious errors.

Reasonable grasp of grammar, reasonable range of vocabulary appropriate to the context and the task.

5 – 8 The language produced contains many errors. Some grasp of grammar and limited vocab.

1 – 4 The language produced contains many errors of a basic nature. Little grasp of grammar and rarely able to manipulate complex language accurately. Limited range of vocabulary appropriate to the context.

AO4 (20 marks)

17 – 20 Excellent critical and analytical response to the question set. Knowledge of the text or film is consistently accurate and detailed. Opinions, views and conclusions are consistently supported by relevant and appropriate evidence from the text or film. The essay demonstrates excellent evaluation of the issues, themes and the cultural and social contexts of the text or film studied.

13 – 16 Good critical and analytical response to the question set. Knowledge usually accurate and detailed. Opinions, views and conclusions are usually supported by relevant and appropriate evidence from the text or film. Good evaluation of the issues, themes and the cultural and social contexts of the text or film studied.

9 – 12 Reasonable critical and analytical response to the question set. Knowledge sometimes accurate and detailed. Sometimes supported by relevant and appropriate evidence. Reasonable evaluation of the issues, themes and the cultural and social contexts of the text or film studied.

5 – 8 Limited response,. Some knowledge demonstrated. Opinions, views and conclusions are occasionally supported by evidence. Limited evaluation of the issues, themes and contexts studied.

1 – 4 Very limited response, a little knowledge of the text or film demonstrated. Opinions, views and conclusions rarely supported. Very limited evaluation of the issues, themes and contexts.
