Some of the challenges sexual assault survivors have here in San Diego are waiting on the testing of the sexual assault kits. There is a backlog of over 2800 rape kits. She has been very vocal about the testing backlog and has urged for more efficiency and expediting the testing of these kits. There are still many challenges that sexual assault survivors currently endure. A sculpture in the shape of a whale is being created from repurposed materials, and it will be at the heart of the first cleanup in OB and will be the start of our whale's migration to neighboring coastal community cleanup events throughout the year. **DesBorder** brings communities together to tackle our waterway pollution. The whale will be used as a collection receptacle for donated cans and bottles to be collected and the CRV will be used to purchase books and donate them to local schools with the non-profit Cans4Books. They are looking for donations to go towards the construction of the whale and donors who make a contribution of \$1,000.00 will have their organizations name placed on the whale permanently.

Club members wanted to prioritize our investments in to the local candidate campaigns that we endorsed.
