What is MCert?

MCert stands for Macleans Certificate. It is the Macleans College Year 11 Programme. It is a content rich programme that will prepare students for moving to either NCEA Level 2 or CIE AS Level in year 12. Each student in Year 11 will study 1 Mathematics course, 1 English course and at least 1 Science + three other subjects.
