

Privacy Policy for Quick Word Counter

Quick Word Counter respects your privacy and is committed to protecting your information.

Information Collection and Use

This extension does not collect, store, or share any personally identifiable information. All functionality runs locally within your browser. No data is transmitted to any external server.

Permissions Usage

The extension requests the following browser permissions solely to provide its core functionality:

- **activeTab** – Used to interact with the currently active webpage when you trigger the extension.
- **contextMenus** – Used to add a "Count Words" option to the browser's right-click context menu.
- **clipboardRead** – Declared as a permission but not actively used. The extension reads text selections directly from the page, including inside iframes and Google Docs.
- **scripting** – Used to run a script on the active page to count words and display the result.
- **host_permissions (<all_urls>)** – Required to allow the extension to function on any webpage you visit.

None of these permissions are used to collect, monitor, or transmit your data.

Data Storage

This extension does not store any user data, browsing history, or clipboard contents.

Third-Party Services

This extension does not use any third-party analytics, tracking, or advertising services. It makes no network requests of any kind.
