Questions:

- Can we put more washing machines in apartment 6 (continuing student apartment)
 - 4 currently of each, one dryer is broken
 - Owned and run by a private company, needs to be reported
 - Mike will look into this
- More lighting on Oakes path, has been discussed before
 - Suggest there be another emergency phone on the end, and one in the middle
 - A few dark spots
 - New director for office of emergency services, seems very proactive
- More emergency phones on campus
 - One by Oakes circle is broken
- Could non-affiliated residents of the community they live in get stickers from the current community they live in?
 - Unfortunately no
- Could the pool room be open on the weekends?
 - Look into it, probably a staffing issue
 - CSOs?

 - Unpopular among other students

- May be able to reduce meat options
- ENVS majors focus on waste and recycling, compost system, college gardens?
 - Kresge used to have a good compost system
 - DH have trouble finding where to put the large volumes of food waste
 - Silas
- CRSN 151A taking recyclables to nearby centers
 - We can't do this with campus trash
- EV chargers: TAPS said it would be a several years long process
 - O What does this mean?
 - Talked to Dan Henderson, said it would be long-range process, costs a lot of money, definitely in the future
- Bus transportation
 - No way to track loop buses—-> unpredictable
 - Tracking app?
 - Pass question on to Danny
 - Consistency on Fri and Sat evening
 - Expanding shuttle service to 3 instead of 2 buses
- Tour schedule: spring tour schedule
 - Buses designated for visitors, makes transportation more difficult
 - Mike doesn't know but can ask
- Signage on waste bins is inconsistent
 - High contamination rates
 - Why continue as we are?
 - Potential solutions?
 - Compartmentalization
 - UCSC tried to do single-stream
 - Students don't care
 - New SUA/UCSC Prez/Sust. Office video coming out for new freshman
 - Students are unaware that all recyclables go to the trash, make this more transparent
- ResWiFi forces you to sign in every few days, and is unreliable
 - Put warning in place when the pop-up comes up to download new software
 - Mass email IT to complain and make them do something
 - Submit and IT ticket
 - ResWiFi has stopped connecting to students phones

- RCC and school is not quite set up to continue online and hybrid classes (in-person, hybrid, or remote learning is up to the professor at this point)
 - Few locations on campus to have your Zoom classes
 - At home is not a conducive environment for learning
 - Designate spaces for Zoom classes
 - Single-occupancy study spaces are needed
 - West-side college or RCC needs to develop a study/learning space
 - Red Room maybe?
 - Needs to be advertised more as a social study space
 - Empty classrooms on campus that can be used as study spaces? Need to be designated as such, emphasize that it changes to a study space at different points
 - Dean of students office
- Slug meals and flexi dollar meal plans can't order ahead of time
 - Can't be used to pre-order at Oakes Cafe
 - Slug meals are designed only for the dining halls
- Has dog, support animal, difficult for people without cars to get their dog to go on playdates with other dogs
 - Dog park on campus?
 - ESA pets can't be off leash or 1pm feet from residence
 - o Difficult to exercise their animals
 - Council could pass a resolution on this to share with upper level folks
 - Little bandwidth to entertain this prospect, but a resolution could help
 - Requires a lot of responsibility on the owners and university
 - Furry Friends Weds March 16th, 1-2pm
- Mental health support services are lacking
 - 4 therapy sessions per year, which is not helpful at all
 - 2 years of covid has exacerbated many students mental health struggles, especially with isolation
 - At the beginning of the year, there were month long wait times for DRC accommodations
 - Way to expedite this?
 - Staffing issue
 - RCC has no CRE

- Many other offices are very low, trying to staff up ASAP
- Staffing is difficult, expensive to live in SC
- Mental health equity fund has been expanded
 - For counselors and wellness programs, student organizations, peer help
 - Could see these at the beginning of next year
 - Emergency response program
 - Police were the only ones who could respond to mental health crises
 - Mental health response team: social worker, nurse would be better and make students feel more comfortable
 - No hospital attached to UCSC makes it harder
- Crosswalk at bus stop is dimly lit, could be dangerous
 - Will look into it
 - Flashing yellow lights
- Soft serve machine at porter is broken, needs to be fixed
 - Talk to the manager, comment cards
 - RCC dining hall does not have a panini press
- Improving bike racks at RCC
 - Has to walk down to Oakes circle, too far away, lots of bike theft
 - More bike racks nearer to apartments
 - There is one behind the apartments, put them into open space
 - E-bike contract, will set up charging stations for e-bikes
