

In Texas, Instructional Setting Codes (PEIMS Data Standard C035) are used to define the specialized environment and amount of time a student with disabilities receives special education services. Key codes for school-age students include 00 for no instructional setting (speech only), 01 for full-time mainstream, 41 for resource room (less than 21% of day), and 44 for self-contained, separate campus (more than 60% of day).

[Instructional Setting Codes \(C035\) - Special Education \(Age 3+\)](#)

- **00:** No Instructional Setting (e.g., Speech Therapy only).
- **01:** Mainstream - Special education/related services are provided in the general education classroom for the entire day.
- **02:** Hospital Class.
- **08:** Vocational Adjustment Class (VAC).
- **31:** Home-based Instruction.
- **32:** Center-based Instruction.
- **34:** Other Environment.
- **41:** Resource Room/Services - Less than 21% of the day.
- **42:** Resource Room/Services - At least 21% and less than 50%.
- **43:** Self-Contained, Mild/Moderate/Severe, Regular Campus - At least 50% and no more than 60%.
- **44:** Self-Contained, Mild/Moderate/Severe, Regular Campus - More than 60%.
- **45:** Full-Time Early Childhood Special Education Setting (ages 3–5).
- **71:** Certified Non-Public Day School.
- **86:** Residential Care and Treatment Facility - Separate Campus.
- **87:** Residential Care and Treatment Facility - Community Class.
- **96:** Off Home Campus - Separate Campus.

These codes are reported during PEIMS submissions to determine funding based on the student's Individualized Education Program (IEP).
