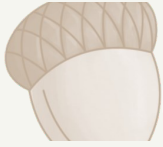

We are in need of a Social Media Officer, Minister of Children, Youth Combat. Please consider applying to help our great Barony.

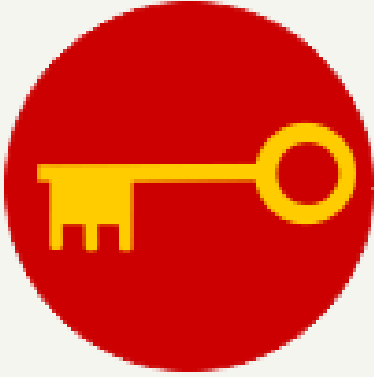
Officers, please remember to get your reports in on time. This is a very important part of your jobs. We appreciate your dedication.

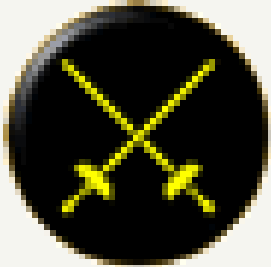

The Cooking Guild of Hestia

Hosts the First Annual Food Joust!!

Warlord 2022

ARE YOU READY FOR THE CHALLENGE?

A friendly competition using modern methods and ingredients to create redactions of period recipes.

Pre-registration will begin on April 15th. Recipes will be required to be submitted to the Cooking Guild of Hestia by May 5th, along with simple documentation, so that the judges can read through them prior to the day of the competition. Judges are not permitted to participate on a team or provide consultation to teams beyond answering questions pertaining to the rules. At the time of registration, we will need to know the name of your team as well as who your Team Leader is and who your additional Team Members will be. Each team needs to include at least three people, but no more than five. Each person on your team must be responsible for researching at least one of the dishes for themselves.

Each team will be required to produce a total of FIVE dishes: Appetizer, Entree, Side, Beverage, and Dessert. **AND YOU ONLY HAVE 4 HOURS!!!!**

NOTE: Neither the Barony of the Steppes, nor the Cooking Guild of Hestia, is in any way responsible for the cost of ingredients or tools used during the Food Joust. Each team is fully responsible for all expenses they might incur by entering this competition.

Ingredients:

Meat: (choose one) Poultry, Pork, Beef

ALL of these remaining ingredients must be used in some manner:

Vegetables: Turnip, Peas, and Carrots

Herbs: Dill, Rosemary, and Thyme

Fruit: Blackberries, Pears, and Plums

Grain: Rice

Bonus ingredient: Anise

Each dish can be awarded up to 50 points with a total of 250 points being possible per team.

Points will be awarded based on: documentation, period recipe, presentation, flavor, and ingredient usage.

All cooking utensils, supplies and on site kitchens are to be provided by the teams. Please provide the following: 1 Full serving for Presentation Judging. 2-3 full servings to be divided among the judges for tasting, 2-3 servings to be divided in "taste portions" of any dishes you wish entered into the "Populace Choice"(including a list of ingredients)

Populace Choice will be a "blind judging", so only the name of the dish and the ingredients list is to be available. The same for the "Populace Choice for Presentation". The name of the person or team is NOT to be anywhere on the presentation.

****REMINDER**** This is an onsite Camp Cooking Competition.

ALL TEAM MEMBERS MUST BE PRESENT TO COMPETE. All foods will be cooked on site, so choose your recipes wisely. Unless you

Da'ud Bob Movie Review *Julius Caesar*



This month's movie review is of a film that can rightfully be thought of as a prequel to another movie, starring the same powerhouse actor playing the same character, that I reviewed for you some nine years ago, in October 2012. Indeed, now that I own DVDs of both of these movies, I can see making them a double-feature bill for watching together some time. This is not to say that either or both of them are what I would consider to be top-tier movies, despite their stellar casts. They have their issues: costuming, miscasting, glaring anachronisms, actors who either are not or at least do not appear to be comfortable with Shakespearean English.

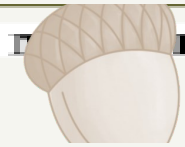
And yet, they have their place in the corpus of productions of Shakespeare plays. And, unsurprisingly, given the overall quality of the actors involved, parts of them are very good and help to make watching them educational and even, at times, enjoyable. Be that as it may, sit back and see what you think, as this month, Da'ud Bob reviews for you the 1970 film production of **Julius Caesar**.

Starring Charlton Heston as Marc Antony (a role he would reprise two years later as star and director of 1972's *Antony and Cleopatra*), Jason Robards as Brutus, John Gielgud as Julius Caesar, Richard Johnson as Cassius, Robert (The Man from UNCLE) Vaughn (wearing a beard) as Casca, Richard (The Three Musketeers and The Four Musketeers) Chamberlain as Octavius Caesar, Diana (The Avengers and Bond girl Tracy Draco) Rigg as Portia, Christopher (too many outstanding roles to recite here) Lee as Artemidorus, Jill Bennett as Calpurnia, and Derek Godfrey as Decius Brutus, I think I have to agree with the tag line for this film: "No grander Caesar... No greater cast!" The plot, of course, is about a plot. The growing ambition of Julius Caesar is a source of major concern to his close friend Brutus. Cassius persuades him to participate in a plot to assassinate Caesar. It turns out they have both sorely underestimated Mark Antony. It is, of course, the same exact plot as the 1953 production starring Marlon Brando (and in which John Gielgud, who is Caesar here, played Cassius) that I reviewed back in October 2002.

Good points: It's Shakespeare's words. The standards of the Roman legions. As usual with a Shakespeare play, there are a number of quotes which have passed into the general vocabulary: "It was Greek to me." "Yon Cassius has a lean and hungry look." "Cry 'Havoc!', and let slip the dogs of war." (You might also recognize this last from Christopher Plummer as the Klingon General Chang in *Star Trek VI: The Undiscovered Country*, which also featured a number of other quotes from various Shakespeare plays.)

Bad points: The costumes are more medieval than they are Roman; that is to say, they are far more tunic than toga. And the colors! So many pastels. (You'd almost think that they made this movie in the 1950s instead of 1970.) Jason Robards as Brutus is often a little wooden, giving most of his lines almost in a monotone. It's only when he is expressing his character's anger that you really start to feel him putting himself into the role. Antony's over tunic. Medieval rather than Roman pavilions. The soldiers' armor. The helmets. Antony's lion's head pauldrons (shoulder armor). Those saddles are not Roman. And they have stirrups! (Stirrups don't appear until almost 1,000 years later.)

Zero breasts. 2½ gallons of blood. 29 dead bodies. Dagger fu. Sword fu. Torch fu. Lance fu. Great Caesar's ghost fu. Cart rolls. Thunder rolls. Cavalrymen roll. Gratuitous vultures. Gratuitous horse skeleton. Gratuitous elephants. (No, really!) Gratuitous dancing girls. Gratuitous sweat. Gratuitous rioting and looting. Gratuitous masseur. Academy Award nomination to a bearded Robert Vaughn as Casca for giving one of his better performances here. A 37 on the Vomit Meter. Two stars (out of four possible). Da'ud Bob says, "It's maybe not the best of Shakespeare, but it is Shakespeare. Check it out!"

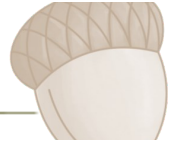
