The 2023 Keweenaw Chain Drive Festival will be a Poker Run. Riders will have the choice of a short, long, and adventure route. Runners will follow the same course as the Short route, but they will have their own start time (11:00 AM). Each route will have multiple poker chip stations at random locations. Riders will collect a chip from each location and submit them to find out their poker hand. The best poker hands will win various prize packages! The ride is free to enter, and riders will have the opportunity to make a donation to the trails during the registration process. All proceeds from the donations will go to supporting the Maasto Hiihto/Churning Rapids and Swedetown trails.

## Registration

In order to submit a poker hand, riders must pre-register for the event using RunSignUp. Pre-registration is required to help us determine the number of chips needed at each station. The ride is free to enter.

## Courses/Maps

Riders will have a choice of a short course (~10 miles), a long course (~22 miles), and an adventure course (~63 miles). Runners will follow the short course (~10 miles). It will be the rider's responsibility to navigate the course. All courses will use well established trails, 2-tracks, and/or roads.

### **Self Supported Ride**

There will not be aid stations on any of the routes. Riders will need to plan accordingly and have their own water, hydration tablets, food, etc., or plan for someone to meet them along the way so they can restock supplies. Adventure Ride participants need to be prepared for a long ride and have the necessary food and hydration. The chalet in Swedetown trails should be open to refill water bottles. The businesses in Calumet are also an option.

### Start time slots

During the registration process, you will be allowed to select your start time from the available time slots. To spread things out and minimize congestion at the poker chip stations, we are limiting the number of riders that can start in each time slot. Please go out during your designated start window.

# Poker Chip Collection/Getting Your Poker Hand

Poker Chip stations will be located at random locations along all of the courses. Riders must collect a chip from each station and submit them to get their poker hand. The chips will have a code on them, and that code corresponds to a playing card on our master list. To submit their "hand", riders will take a picture of their chips (code showing) and e-mail it to <a href="mailto:keweenawchaindrive@gmail.com">keweenawchaindrive@gmail.com</a>. We will decipher each hand and compile them into a list. The top hands from each course will win the prize packages

The 10-Mile course will collect three poker chips, and the 22-Mile and 63-Mile courses will each collect five poker chips.
