Your description must include, at least:

- One paragraph for each question you chose.
- Formal language.
- Two (2) comparatives: underline them.
- Two (2) superlatives: italicize them.
- Four (4) adjectives to describe a city or town: **in bold**.
- Two (2) places that we saw in this unit ("what is there to see?") in **bold**.

You CAN'T use Al or any dictionary or translator. It's just you!
