

CCC Shines General Camp FAQs

What are camp hours?

- Full Day: Monday - Friday, 9:00am - 3:00pm
- Half Day: Monday - Friday, 9:00am - 12:00pm

When is Before/After Care?

- Before Care: 7:45am - 9:00am
 - After Care: 3:00pm - 5:00pm
 - There is no after care on the performance days of camp (Thursday & Friday of the last two weeks). The final day of a session ends with the 2:00pm performance, which lasts approximately 70 minutes.
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What time is Car Line?

- Morning Car Line: 8:50am - 9:10am
 - Afternoon Car Line: 2:45pm - 3:10pm
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What can I expect on performance days?

- Campers are dismissed at the normal time on Thursday Performance Days. There is no after care on Thursday Performance Days.
 - Campers should return by 5:45pm on Thursday evenings performance days for the 7:00pm show.
 - On Friday Performance Days, campers arrive at normal time for a regular camp day and are dismissed immediately following the 2:00pm performances.
 - Performances run approximately 70-85 minutes during the summer.
 - Additional details for each show will be provided during the camp weeks.
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What should my child wear?

- Each camper receives one t-shirt per camp they are registered at our Kick Off Event.
 - Campers should dress comfortably and be ready to be active.
 - Sneakers are required daily to prevent injuries. No flip-flops, even on water days!
 - Campers who do not attend the Summer Camp Kickoff Event will receive their camp shirts on the first day.
 - Campers must wear their camp t-shirt every day, except on theme days.
 - Please apply sunscreen daily before camp.
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How are campers grouped?

- Campers are grouped by age/grade.
 - Groups rotate together through camp schedules.
 - Requests must be made in advance and are not guaranteed. Requests made after camp begins can not be accommodated as planning occurs in advance and we must ensure the safety of our campers and staff.
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What if my child takes medication?

- If your child takes medication during camp, please contact staff with the necessary medication information and guidelines.
 - For children carrying an EPI-Pen or other emergency medication, a spare must be provided to CCC that staff travels with throughout the day with your child.
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Will my child need a costume for the performances?

- Families will receive an email with costume information if their child is cast in a lead or supporting role.
 - Most campers will wear their camp t-shirt and shorts for performances.
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What can my camper expect?

Each day, campers will rotate through a variety of classes, including:

- Music
- Dance
- Art
- Acting
- Faith Formation
- Behind-the-Scenes Workshops
- Games

These classes are designed to enhance campers' theater skills and prepare them for the final production.

- The last few days of camp focus on final rehearsals and production preparation.
 - Performances for two week camps take place on the final Thursday of camp at 7:00pm and the final Friday at 2:00pm.
 - Performances for the one week Music Theater Intensive Program take place on the final day of camp at 2:00pm.
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How are payments handled?

- All payments should be made through the **Parent Dashboard**.

- **Final payments** are due the **1st of the month** for that camp (June 1st, July 1st, August 1st).
 - You can view your invoices on the Parent Dashboard under the **Finance tab**.
 - Additional payments can be made if you wish to pay more than the current amount due.
 - If you are scheduled for **Auto Pay**, please do not make additional payments unless you notify us prior to the auto payment date.
 - There is a **CARES package** available on your profile. You can add it before camp starts. If you use CARES as needed, the amount due will be charged to the primary card on file on the last day of camp.
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How do I know if my child is a full day or half day camper?

- Students entering PreK-4 will be automatically enrolled as half day campers
- Children entering Kindergarten have the choice to enroll as full day or half day campers
- Children entering 1st grade and up are expected to enroll as full day campers
- We are sometimes able to accommodate children entering PreK-4 as full day campers if they have completed a full year of school as a full day student. If this is your circumstance, please reach out to our staff so we can assist you in enrolling your 4 year old.
