



Problem	Possible Solutions
<b>Swallowing</b>	Refer to GP practice for Medication review by Pharmacist/GP Use a different form of medication e.g: -Liquid -Patch -Dispersible tablet Seek advice if medication can be crushed. Can medication regimen be simplified by clinician.
<b>Dexterity</b>	Could community pharmacy provide; -screw/winged lids -large bottles/boxes? -Pop foil medicines into bottles -Halved tablets Relative/carer administers all (or some) medication
<b>Vision</b>	Could community pharmacy provide; -large print labels -symbols/colour code each medication -Braille labels (if possible) Relative/carer administers all (or some) medication
<b>Understanding</b>	Can community pharmacy provide; A Medicines Reminder Sheet Can medication regimen be simplified by clinician or further information provided on the dispensing label such as what medication is prescribed for (such as laxido (dose) for constipation)
<b>Memory</b>	Simplify medication regimen Managed Repeats Delivery service Alarm systems (phone, smart-speakers such as alexa)
