General Information and Highlighted Rules

Welcome!

Thank you for registering for the 4th Timmons Tee Party. It is my goal to provide an event format that you will enjoy. You can add to the enjoyment factor of the atmosphere as well by being considerate of PDGA rules and of your fellow competitors.

Tournament Central & Bathrooms: Tournament Central will be at the top of the hill on the path leading to hole 1. Bathrooms are onsite next to Pickleball Courts.

Lunch: There are several fast-food options nearby. I will be posting the second-round hole assignments on the PDGA results page so you know where to go for round 2. There should be about a 1 hour delay between the last cards being finalized and the start of round 2. **Keep in mind that parking is usually at a premium at Timmons. You may want to consider bringing your lunch or having it delivered.**

PDGA Live Scoring: Starting this year, all players on each card must keep score. If you fail to turn in a scorecard, turn one in late, or turn in an incorrect scorecard, you will be penalized. I do not want to have to penalize anyone for this, so I suggest everyone on the card keep score in PDGA Live scoring. This guarantees your scorecard matches your card mates, and as long as you submit your scorecard at the end, you should be good to go. Feel free to verify with me to confirm your scorecard was properly submitted. To login to live scoring, go to [PDGA.com/score](https://www.pdga.com/score) and enter the passcode (Timmons) If you have more questions, refer to live scoring FAQ on the PDGA.com site. **If you have to use paper scorecards, please let me know when you get this so I can be prepared.**

Player Packs and Vending: Player packs will consist of a voucher to choose your own player pack items. We will have Down South Disc inventory onsite all day for your plastic and disc golf accessory needs.

Schedule of Events: Saturday June 29th, 2024

0725-0825: Check in and pick up your player pack. If you do not check in with me before 8:25 AM, you may lose your spot.

0830-0835: Quick Player Meeting

0900: First round tee times shotgun start.

1300 (Approximate): 2nd round will begin. (I will send the exact 2nd round time to the email list for the event and post on the Disc Golf Scene Page comments. It will be about an hour after all 1st round scores have been submitted and have been updated online.)

4:00 PM (Approximate): Awards and payouts will occur when all division participants have completed their rounds.

OB and Course Rules

Make sure you are familiar with the PDGA Competition Manual and Official Rules of Disc Golf. All PDGA rules shall be observed. Any water on course not specified on a hole should be considered casual relief. (806.03 Casual Area) Should your shot fall in an area where OB flags have ended, use an infinite line between the last two flags to indicate extension of OB line. If you need a TD ruling for an issue on the course, you can call my cell or play a provisional and discuss the issue with me after the round **BEFORE YOU TURN IN YOUR SCORES!**

3	3	215			Double Mando. Tee serves as Drop Zone if missed. OB creek (flagged). Baseball field fence and across is OB.
4	3	210			Mando. Tee serves as Drop Zone if missed. OB creek (flagged), fence (long), baseball field. Cash CTP
5	3	385			OB creek (flagged).
6	3	230			OB creek (flagged). The flagged OB in front of tee box is in play for this hole.
7	3	210			OB creek (flagged). Cash CTP. Be aware of flagged OB long and right. Flags are well inside the edge of the creek.
8	3	190			Both sides of creek are in bounds. OB surrounded by water in creek.
9	3	180			OB creek (flagged).
10	3	275			OB creek (flagged) and road. Be careful of your follow through with the tree on the front right of the tee box. Recommend throwing from the back of the box to avoid possible injury to hand in follow through. I have extended tee box to allow more runup space and still avoid tree.
11	3	320			OB creek (flagged), and road. Blue flagged section in front of basket is casual relief (Relief can be taken along line of play away from basket until you reach stable ground and no further).
12	3	275			OB creek (flagged), and road.
13	3	305			Both sides of creek are in bounds. Creek between 13's and 17's fairways is casual (Relief can be taken along line of play away from basket until you reach stable ground and no further). OB surrounded by water in main creek. Road (surrounded by pavement) and beyond is OB.
14	3	160			Cash CTP
15	3	240

17	3	210			Creek between 13's and 17's fairways is casual (Relief can be taken along line of play away from basket until you reach stable ground and no further). OB creek long (flagged). Cash CTP
18	3	370			OB creek (flagged).
