Summer Opportunity at Rowan University

The Think Like an Entrepreneur Summer Academy is a four-day, **non-residential**, educational experience for rising high school juniors and seniors entering the 2024-2025 academic year run by the [School of Innovation and Entrepreneurship](#) in the Rohrer College of Business. The Academy is held in person on Rowan University's campus in Glassboro, NJ, and runs Monday, June 24 - Thursday, June 27, from 9 AM-2:30 PM.

Thanks to the generous support of the TD Charitable Foundation, participation in the academy is free and all students who successfully complete the program will earn 3 college credits, equivalent to 1 college course, which can be used at Rowan University or transferred to another university.

Most colleges require a counselor's letter of recommendation. Students will need to complete the following questionnaire before May 26, 2024.
