Delegates from all over the world have gathered in New York City at the UN building in order to solve some of the world's major global issues:

- 1. Climate Change/Pollution
- 2. Food/Water Shortages
- 3. Health
- 4. Terrorism/WMDs
- 5. Refugees/Migrants/Immigrants
- 6. Third World Poverty
- 7. Human Rights Violations

Delegates will be divided into these potential groups and are challenged with the task to develop a <u>resolution plan</u> that will solve these major global issues. This resolution plan needs to address the following in order to be considered for Security Council ratification:

- -- Plan is professionally presented with relevant AV aids
- -- Plan discusses 5W's of what the issue involves
- -- Plan reflects the needs of regional/global areas of the world
- -- Plan explains what should be done to solve the problem
- -- Plan deflects or counters possible opposition

The Security Council ratification procedure will consist of the following steps:

- 1. Formation of Security Council: 15 total representatives of which 5 are permanent members who have veto power [US, GB, FR, RUSSIA & CHINA]
- 2. Groups present resolution plans one at a time
- 3. Q&A discussion
- 4. Vote= any vetoes?, then 5/10 yes votes needed for ratification
