#### CAMPER REGISTRATION PROCESS

##### **Registration opens January 1, 2026**

**Step 1:** Sign up with your local Church Camp Coordinator. They will give you their email address for registration.

**Step 2:** Provide a non-refundable \$100 deposit to your Camp Coordinator.

**Step 3:** Complete the online registration (Link provided in Parent and Camper Prep Center)

**\*\*\*Complete steps 1-3 BEFORE the rate deadline to secure desired pricing.\*\*\***

**Step 4:** Submit your final balance and signed waiver to your camp coordinator.

#### DEVICES

We believe camp to be an opportunity for students to disengage from normal day to day distractions in order to have an encounter with Jesus and build relationships with other students and adults. Therefore, no electronic devices are allowed during camp. Should your camper bring a device to camp, he/she will not be allowed to use it. If a camper is found to be

using a device, it will be taken from the camper until camp ends. Leaving devices at home also prevents broken or stolen devices, so please keep them at home!
