• Attendance Procedures

In addition to calling the BC attendance phone line (262-785-3994), families can also send an email to <u>BCHSattendance@elmbrookschools.org</u> to report an absence to school. When reporting an absence, please provide the student's name and reason for the absence. All Parents/Guardians will receive a monthly attendance summary for each of their students. Additionally, we encourage students and parents to regularly monitor attendance records by logging into Infinite Campus for review.

Chromebook
