In C - Chorus and Verses are the same

Verse

In a [C] cavern in a canyon excavating for a [G7] mine
[G7] Dwelt a miner forty-[C]-niner and his [G7] daughter Clemin-[C]-tine

Chorus (same as Verse)

Oh my [C] darlin', oh my darlin', oh my darlin' Clemin-[G7]-tine
[G7] You are lost and gone for-[C]-ever dreadful [G7] sorry Clemin-[C]-tine.

In F#m (same chords as A) - Chorus and Verses are different

Verse

[F#m] In a [A] cavern in a [E] canyon exca-[Bm]-vating for a [F#m] mine
[F#m] Dwelt a [A] miner forty-[E]-niner and his [D] daughter Clemin-[F#m]-tine
[F#m]
[F#m] Light she [A] was and like a [E] fairy and her [Bm] shoes were number [F#m] nine,
[F#m] Herring [A] boxes, without [E] topses, sandals [D] were for Clemen-[F#m]-tine.

Chorus (different from Verse)

[F#m] Clemin-[A]-tine. Clemin-[F#m]-tine. Oh my [A] darling, Clemin-[D]-tine.

Drove she ducklings to the water ev'ry morning just at nine,
Hit her foot there against a splinter, fell into the foaming brine.
Ruby lips above the water, blowing bubbles, soft and fine,
But, alas, I was no swimmer, so I lost my Clementine.

[F#m] Clemin-[A]-tine. Clemin-[F#m]-tine. Oh my [A] darling, Clemin-[D]-tine.

Then the miner, 49er soon began to peak and pine
thought he aughta join his daughter now he's left with clementine
in my dreams she still does haunt me broken garments soaked in brine
