# **PSRG Board Meeting**

- 1. Meeting called to order at 13:35.
- 2. Board members present :

## **Old Business**

- 3. **Previous meetings** approved unanimously.
- 4. 6m repeater project. Update from Doug KD7DK: the first antenna has been installed with help from Alan AC7MX at Beacon Hill; we have identified a mounting location for an antenna at Capitol Park. The 6m system will be based on Allstar, as is our current 2m system. We do not intend to link them full-time, but will link them during the weekly PSRG net and the ACS net; they will probably not be linked during the Nine O'clock Net or the Noon Net. We aim to run the transmitter at 30W and into an amplifier pushing 200W.
- 5. Webpage changes. Update from Rich K7RCH: things are in transition, but we aim to simplify the menu system and make things easier to find. Rich is open to suggestions and continues to work on moving things around. He and Quentin K7DRQ are still to test the new membership plugin. Rich also has a new tool to remove certain posts by some fixed time -- for instance, to remove board meeting notices after the meetings take place. Rich K7RCH is also evaluating accessibility on the website to ensure we improve our accessibility status. Jym W7JYM has volunteered his help around accessibility.
- **6. Field Day.** There are three groups that have collaborated in the past and will do so again this year : PSRG, Seattle ACS, and West Seattle ARC. Guidance from the ARRL is very similar to last year, with the event being "remote" or "socially distanced". Detailed instructions will be made available for online log submission soon. We will do a Field Day Briefing Zoom call the week of Field Day.
- 7. Annual Picnic. The Annual Picnic is back this year at Magnolia Park on Sunday July 25th, starting around 11:00. The Rain or Shine Net will be running there, as well as the Noon Net. Jack KI7RMU will speak with Todd WA7FOX about food, but we will also run a potluck-style picnic. We will be running an HF station and a fox hunt, thanks to foxes from Curt WR5J.
