



Dress Code

LLCA students are expected to dress in proper uniform attire at all times.

Benefits of having a required uniform policy:

- Reduces peer pressure
- Helps break down socioeconomic barriers
- Lower cost
- Helps improve student conduct
- Assists in the ease and convenience of choosing a wardrobe
- Helps with quick identification of students on field trips
- Creates a more serious classroom atmosphere
- Promotes a positive student and school image
- Promotes pride, school identity, and a sense of belonging

It is the responsibility of the parents or guardians and students to ensure compliance with the uniform dress code. The parent or guardian may be called to bring proper uniform items to school for any student arriving out of uniform.

The school administration reserves the right to determine appropriateness of dress in cases not covered by the dress code or in other cases that may arise.

Please put your child's name on all uniform items so they can be returned if found.

Shirts:

1. Students may choose from a cobalt blue or white knit polo and t-shirts, long-sleeved Oxford (boys) or short/three-quarter sleeve blouses (girls) with collar of their choice.
2. **All shirts must have the pre-approved school logo embroidered/screen printed on the left chest pocket and no other visible brand logos.**
3. If an undershirt is visible, it must be solid white, solid blue, or solid black
4. **High school students only may wear black knit polo or t-shirts** which also have the pre-approved school logo embroidered/screen printed on the left chest pocket.

Bottoms:

- **Students may wear black or khaki (shorts, capris, pants, skorts, knee length skirt) in the uniform line of clothing..**
- Skirts/skorts: skirts or skorts must be knee length (top of the knee or lower)
- All bottoms should be without rips or holes.
- No cargo shorts, cargo pants, yoga pants, jeggings, leggings, jogger pants, athletic shorts/pants etc.

Jumpers:

- For K-5 students only
- Must be solid khaki or school plaid
- Must wear shorts or leggings underneath
- Royal/Cobalt blue polo dresses from Lands' End with the school logo have been approved for K-5 girls. No other vendors are approved at this time. Shorts or leggings must be worn underneath.

Skorts:

- Must be solid khaki or school plaid.

Shoes:

- Students may wear **brown, black, white, gray or royal (school blue) shoes** or combination thereof of their choice. Shoe laces and soles must be black, white, gray or royal (school blue) as well. **No other colors are permitted.** Logos must be smaller than the size of a standard business card.
- Students **may not wear sandals, flip flops, crocs, mules, boots, high heels, etc.** Shoes must completely cover the foot, must be securely tied at all times, and must fit properly.
- **Athletic shoes will be required for gym use**, and they are strongly recommended in general.

Belts:

- Students are encouraged to wear belts, which may be brown or black belts or a combination thereof or school plaid.
- Buckles may be silver, gold, brass, black and may not have any pictures, words, logos, or symbols. Buckles must be modest in size.
- **Belts are encouraged but not required.**

Jackets/Coats/Sweaters/Vests: (These items may be worn in the classroom.)

- Students may wear approved items from our three uniform vendors.
- Approved hoodies from LLCA sports teams or extracurricular organizations may also be worn.
- Approved royal blue or white sweatshirt from PTO
- Solid-colored hoodies, cardigan sweaters, sweater vests, and pullover crew or v-neck sweaters with a logo smaller than the size of a standard business card are permitted. (Acceptable colors: black, royal blue or gray)

****All other jackets/coats are not permitted at school, but may be worn when riding the school bus.****

Socks: Socks must be worn at all times. Socks may be up to knee high in length. Socks must be matching and solid in color. Acceptable colors are white, black, royal blue, or gray. Socks sold as a fundraiser for the PTO may also be worn.

Tights/Leggings: Girls may wear solid white or solid black tights or leggings in conjunction with a skirt/skort/jumper. There should be no patterns. Tights and leggings of any type are not permitted to be worn without a skirt/skort/jumper. Tights and leggings regardless of color or style cannot be worn in the place of uniform pants, shorts, or other attire.

Other Uniform Requirements:

1. Students may not wear hats, ballcaps, bandanas or other non-approved head coverings at school. (Exception: religious observance; medical reasons or spirit days where hats are allowed.)
2. Backpacks, lunch boxes, and purses may not have inappropriate writing.
3. Blankets, wraps and pillows may not be brought to school.
4. Colognes, perfumes, and body spray/splashes must be worn in moderation. These items are to be left at home and not in backpacks or lockers. (Stick or roll-on deodorant is allowed)
