[Nurse Corps Scholarship Program](#) - If accepted, we pay your tuition, fees, and other educational costs, along with a monthly stipend. In return, after you graduate, you work at an eligible health care facility with a critical shortage of nurses.

[Future Health Professionals](#) - Deadline: April 15, 2026

University of Portland scholarships - Merit considered at time of application. Annual & Endowed Scholarships are announced during the first two weeks of fall semester.

[Ford Scholars Program](#) * - The Ford Scholars Program is for graduating high school seniors (or equivalent) who have never enrolled full time in a 2- or 4- year college and seeking a bachelor's degree. This program is offered in both Oregon and Siskiyou County, Calif.

[Ford Transfer Scholars Program](#) - The Ford Transfer Scholars Program offers a comprehensive, need-based scholarship to high performing community college students under the age of 25 planning to transfer to a full-time bachelor's degree program. Up to 25 renewable scholarships are awarded each year to residents of Oregon and Siskiyou County, California.

[The Gates Scholarship](#) * - The Gates Scholarship (TGS) is a highly selective, last-dollar scholarship for outstanding, minority, high school seniors from low-income households. Each year, the scholarship is awarded to exceptional student leaders, with the intent of helping them realize their maximum potential.

[Kaiser Permanente Health Equity Scholars](#) * - The Kaiser Permanente Health Equity Scholars Program supports young leaders who have a demonstrated interest in pursuing a clinical (e.g., pharmacist, physician, practitioner, nurse) or non-clinical (e.g., accounting, business administration, human resources, marketing, public policy) career in the healthcare industry.

[Moore Inklings Scholarship](#) - The Moore Inklings Scholarship offers up to \$10,000 to support students who center their Christian faith while demonstrating leadership, service, and campus engagement. Must show academic ability with a 3.25 GPA or higher. Juniors, seniors, and graduate students are eligible to be nominated by a UP official by April 1.

[Oregon Nurses Foundation](#) * - To help address the looming nursing shortage in Oregon, and to ensure that diverse individuals from all walks of life can afford to enter the profession of nursing (or pursue advanced degrees in nursing practice), ONF offers a range of scholarships to help offset the costs of nursing study.

[Renaissance Scholars Program](#) * - Renaissance Scholars Program focuses on providing renewable college scholarships to talented students with significant financial need who will be the first in their family to receive a bachelor's degree. Application open to high school seniors in Oregon and Illinois and current college students in Oregon.

[Trinity Education Foundation](#) * - The Trinity Scholars Program (TSP) offers renewable \$10,000 college scholarships to undergraduate students attending an accredited Christian college in Oregon, Washington, Idaho or Montana. TSP students receive coaching and mentorship support in addition to their scholarship funding. The Foundation also offers specific scholarship opportunities for undergraduate environmental studies and graduate leadership programs.

Avel Louise Gordly Scholarship for Oregon Black Women - For Black women graduates of Oregon high schools to pursue and complete a degree in postsecondary education in Oregon, or at one of the Historically Black Colleges and Universities of the United States. Download the [application](#).

Dr. Ernest Hartzog Founder's Scholarship - For Black/African American graduates or graduating seniors of a high school in Oregon. Preference is given to students passionate about giving back to their community and uplifting the next generation. Download the [application](#).

Embark's Diversity in Leadership Scholarship - For underrepresented and diverse Oregon residents pursuing their first year of enrollment at an institution of higher education in Oregon. Download the [application](#).

Institute for Cultural Initiatives Scholarship - For bi-lingual (Spanish/English) Latino students pursuing education at Oregon community colleges. Download the [application](#).

Pence Contractors Diversity in Leadership Scholarship - For underrepresented students to major in construction engineering at an institution of postsecondary education in Oregon or aspiring to careers in that field, with preference for Multnomah County residents. Download the [application](#).

Thornton Scholarship - For economically disadvantaged Black male graduates of Portland-area high schools who are enrolling at an institution of higher education anywhere in the United States. Download the [application](#).

[LaVerne "Bun" Young Memorial Scholarship](#) - To support students pursuing education, medicine, nursing, or teaching at Rogue Community College or Southern Oregon University.

[National American Arab Nurses Association Scholarships for Nursing](#) - To provide financial assistance to applicants who are engaged in studying nursing at the associate degree, bachelor's degree, and master's degree or RN-BSN levels

[The Alice/Jeanne Wagner Memorial Scholarship](#) - provides financial assistance to high school seniors and undergraduate students who have been academically successful. Nursing students seeking an associate or bachelor's degree are welcome to apply. **Deadline 2/1/26.** No Essay, Need-Based: Yes, Merit-Based: No

[Oregon Nurses Foundation Centennial Education Scholarship](#) - (after you've started college) Opens: 2/1/2026, Closes: 5/1/2026. Oregon Nurses Foundation Equity Scholarship provides financial assistance to members of underrepresented groups accepted to a nursing program in Oregon to work on an associate or bachelor's degree. Essay Required: No; Need-Based: Yes; Merit-Based: Yes

[Abby's Closet Dreams Scholarship](#) - Deadline 2/8/26. Four annual scholarships to graduating seniors from high schools in Oregon or Southwest Washington who will be enrolling in one of the following institutions in the upcoming fall:

- Elaine A. Davis Memorial Scholarship for Healthcare Fields (\$3,000) (Note: All applicants who will be studying for a career in a healthcare field will be considered for this scholarship.)
- 4- Year University or College (\$3,000)
- Community College (\$2,000)
- Trade School (\$1,500)

[Pacific Northwest Kiwanis Foundation Key Club Scholarship](#) - Deadline 2/1/26. Seven scholarships of at least \$1000 are available to Key Club members accepted into college or university.

[Renaissance Scholars Program](#) - Deadlines 2/1/26 and 5/1/26. to talented first-generation students with significant financial need. The Program offers a renewable college scholarship of up to \$5,000 per academic year (a maximum of \$20,000 toward your bachelor's degree). Recipients are chosen for their demonstrated strength of character and a strong work ethic. Essay Required: Yes; Need-Based: Yes; Merit-Based: Yes. U.S. citizenship is not a requirement (see [FAQ section](#) for more). Must be a first-generation college student. Students who have a parent with a bachelor's degree are not eligible. (see [FAQ section](#) for more).* Have significant demonstrated financial need. Renaissance defines this as Pell eligibility or equivalent for those who do not file the FAFSA. Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 and show academic achievement. Not applicable for community college.

[David Lee Quan Memorial Scholarship](#) - Awarded to a student who has volunteered in a healthcare or medical setting, and intends to major in the medical health field. Deadline 4/1/26.

[Sheung Mou and Fenge Tam Scholarship](#) - This scholarship will be awarded to a first generation college student of any ethnicity. Deadline 4/1/2026.

[Fred G. and Betty Jean Lee Memorial Scholarships](#) - Number of recipients: 4. At least one scholarship will be awarded to a student who attends a college in Oregon or Washington State, and one scholarship will be for a student going to a trade school or community college. These recipients will be selected based on the following: scholarship, leadership in school, and community activities. Being active in school and community activities, especially in leadership roles is particularly important. Deadline 4/1/2026.

OSEA, Chapter 71 will award up to ten (10) scholarships of \$500.00 each to graduating seniors desiring to further their education in any community college, vocational or trade school, or four-year university.

This award is designed to provide assistance to children of Chapter 71 members as they pursue education beyond high school. At least one parent or legal guardian must be an active member of Oregon School Employees Association (OSEA) Chapter 71, as of the application deadline.

- Application: [Apply here](#) - Deadline: most likely mid-April (not yet announced)
- Scholarship: Chapter 71, OSEA Scholarship for children of Chapter 71 classified employees of NC12.
- Amount: \$500.00 scholarship for the school year. Generally awarded in June
- Purpose: To provide financial assistance to a graduating senior who is the child of a NC12 Chapter 71 (OSEA) classified employee, and who wishes to further education beyond high school.
- Applicant must:
- * be a student whose parent or guardian is a classified employee (Chapter 71, OSEA) employed by North Clackamas School District, who is also an active OSEA member.
 - * be a high school senior (or previous term high school graduate).
 - * have a minimum cumulative 2.0 GPA.
 - * submit all supporting documents with scholarship application, by application deadline.
 - * if chosen as a recipient, enroll in or be enrolled in a school or training/trade program and work toward satisfactory progress and successful completion.
