

WOW! Keyboard Buying Guide

There are four really good options we generally recommend:

1) Casio CTK2550 61-Key keyboard package (\$140) This package includes the keyboard, a keyboard stand, headphones and a power cable. 61 keys is fine for a beginner, but you'll want to pick up a foot pedal, and a bench is helpful, too. The plus for this keyboard is it's small, and there are lots of cool sounds built-in, which can add an element of fun. 2) Hamzer 88-Key Keyboard (\$190) A full-sized, 88-key keyboard at the price of a typical 61-key keyboard. The plus is, no need to upgrade when you get into more advanced songs that require a full-sized keyboard. Comes with power supply AND foot pedal, but you'll need a stand and a bench (see above). 4) Yamaha P71 88-Key Weighted Action Digital Piano Package (\$480) This is also a full-sized, 88-key keyboard, but with weighted keys for a more realistic piano feel. 5) Casio PX-770 88-Key Weighted Action Digital Home Piano (\$900) These are the digital pianos used at WOW: Full-sized, 88-key digital piano with elegant wood paneling to give the presence of a real piano without the size & bulk. Advanced technology gives these pianos incredibly realistic sound and feel, along with many additional keyboard sounds. Be sure to order a bench.
