The UC Berkeley Library Dataverse is managed and maintained by the Library Data Services Program and Library IT and was deployed using the <u>Dataverse application</u>, an open-source repository software for archiving, sharing, and accessing data developed by the <u>Institute of Quantitative Social Science (IQSS) at Harvard University</u>. All data in the UC Berkeley Library Dataverse has been acquired and licensed by the library for use by UC Berkeley and Lawrence Berkeley National Lab students, faculty, and staff.

All acquired data that has a license signed by UC Berkeley Library AND:

- Is available to all users without restriction to specific user groups note: there are some exceptions of data provided by the Business Library
- Is stored locally OR
- Is a subscription (must be data only content e.g. Sage Data, ICPSR, Nielsen marketing data, WRDS data)
- Can be manipulated either in the platform or after download

Not included in UC Berkeley Library Dataverse:

- GIS data and data resources. Please visit <u>UC Berkeley Library's GeoData Portal</u>
- Databases that have data and additional content in the form of reports, articles, etc.

Data records and terms are viewable by any user, regardless of affiliation. Please login to the repository using a Calnet ID and passphrase to view and download data files. Note that accessing some data files requires agreeing to the terms of use as listed in the guestbook functionality.
