



ENROLLMENT CHECKLIST

Early College High School Admission's Process for entering 9th grade scholars

STEP 1	<p>Sign up for our TCC Enrollment Session.</p> <p>Parents and scholars must complete the TCC Application. Failure to enroll into a Texas college will forfeit scholar's attendance at Early College High School.</p> <p>SCHEDULE TCC ENROLLMENT SESSION HERE</p> <p><u>Have the following documents ready if requested by TCC SE:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Birth Certificate OR• Permanent Resident - (I-551 must be submitted) OR• United States as a Refugee, Asylee, Parolee or under Temporary Protective Status - (I-94 must be submitted) OR• Current Visa - contact TCC international admission's office for assistance
STEP 2	<p>Submit Shirt Size & Transportation Request</p> <p>SUBMIT SHIRT SIZE & TRANSPORTATION HERE</p>
STEP 3	<p>Submit Student's TCC ID Number</p> <p>SUBMIT TCC ID NUMBER HERE</p> <p>After you submit your Apply TCC application, within 7-14 days you will receive a TCC identification number to the email used to enroll into college. Once you receive the TCC IDN, report your number to ECHS. This is also the time to activate your ID by setting up your TCC email address so that you can check it daily during the school year.</p>
STEP 4	<p>Confirm Bootcamp Attendance</p> <p>SUBMIT BOOTCAMP ATTENDANCE</p> <p>Your scholar will need to bring the following to bootcamp in order to take TSIA2 ELAR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• School ID Card or• US Passport
STEP 5	<p>Submit MISD Registration in Skyward & submit Proof of Residency to the ECHS office in July</p>
STEP 6	<p>If the student is a Bus rider, confirm bus route information in August.</p>
