Hospitality Team Overview

What do we do as a Hospitality Team?

The hospitality team's mission is to serve our church and community through the sharing of food and beverage. The team will set up, serve, and tear down food services for our church events including Sunday Gatherings, Church-wide prayer meetings, Hotdog Sundays, Explore Retreats, Study Halls, and more!

Our Sunday Morning Events:

- Sunday Morning Coffee and Cookies
 - Every Sunday, we set up a coffee cookies and other snacks in the gallery for everyone to enjoy.
 - If you serve for this event, you will be responsible for brewing coffee and setting up tables with cookies and other snacks and supplies before service, tearing down and cleaning up after service.
- Hot Dog Sundays
 - These events happen about once a month, and we serve a hot dog lunch. During cold months, this meal will take place in the gallery, but during warm months, we all have a picnic outside next to the parking lot.
 - If you serve for this event, you can volunteer for many different jobs, including: arrive early to set up, grill the hot dogs during service, serve hot dogs during the event, help teardown and clean up afterwards.
- Special Sunday Treats
 - Every once in a while, we will celebrate as a church family with a special treat.
 Most notably, we do these on holidays like Easter, Mother's Day and Father's Day and Christmas Eve Eve.

Non-Sunday/Other Hospitality Events:

- Explore Retreats
 - 4 times each year, the church hosts Explore Retreats for people interested in learning more about our church beliefs and membership. We like to make these attendees feel loved through providing snacks on Friday night, light continental breakfast on Saturday morning, and lunch on Saturday afternoon.
 - If you volunteer to serve for this event, you would purchase and/or prepare food for this event and set it up at the church office. Any purchases you make for the church are reimbursable.
- Study Halls
 - Study Halls are opportunities for members of our church to participate in a topic-driven bible study series. Breakfast is served at these events.

These serving opportunities do require a little more prep work, but they are a great service opportunity if you like to make meals to share with others, or you're looking for opportunities other than Sunday mornings to serve our church family.
