Location:

The festival will be held in the parking lot on the west side of the Fayetteville Free Library.

Eligibility:

- Items sold must be original and handcrafted or written by the displaying artist. The exhibitor must be the designer and creator of the art.
- Authors and artists must live locally, within a 25 mile radius of the Fayetteville Free Library.
- Authors and artists must be 18 years or older.

Advertising & Promotion:

Advertising of the event will include a broadcast, signs/posters, library newsletter, and social media.

NYS Sales Tax:

Artists are responsible for collecting, reporting, and submitting New York State sales tax. For information and to register, contact NYS Department of Tax and Finance, at (518)485-2889 or online at www.Tax.NY.GOV/bus/st/register.htm.

INFO FOR APPLYING

Application Process:

Applications must be submitted by May 15, 2025, to be considered. Four (4) digital images of items must be included in order for an application to be considered.

Booth Fee:

If notified of acceptance, vendors will be asked to submit a \$50 booth deposit. Vendors who attend the festival will then receive a \$25 refund check at the event, making the total \$25 for booth space at this event.

Categories:

Items to show and/or sell must be in one of the following categories:

- Book
- Clay
- Drawing
- Fiber
- Glass
- Jewelry

- Metal
- Painting
- Photography
- Sculpture
- Wood

Acceptance Process:

Applicants will be notified on June 13th by email of their acceptance into the festival.

DAY OF THE FESTIVAL

Artists must register prior to setting up their booth. Registration begins at 8am. All artists' vehicles must be moved to street parking behind the library by 9:30am. All booths must be set up and ready for viewing by 9:45am.

RULES/REGULATIONS

- All artwork and books must be the original work of the displaying artist.
- The displaying artist must be present for the entire festival. Artists must provide their own back-up if short breaks are needed.
- Booths areas are to look professional at all times.
- Artists must comply with all safety requirements, including weighted tents, fire lane provisions, and vehicles must be parked in designated areas.
- Artists must be 18 years or older.

BOOTH INFORMATION

Booth spaces are approximately 12' wide by 12' deep on pavement in the west parking lot of the library. Booths are set up in straight lines along each side of the parking lot, facing the center of the lot. Booths will be assigned on the day of the event. A map showing the numbered booths will be provided.

Artists are to provide their own tent for set up, as well as all necessary racks, tables, chairs, and fixtures for their display. Tents must be properly weighted on all corners. Weights will not be provided by the festival. Stakes are not allowed. Any property damage caused by the artist's actions, display, tent, or vehicle will be the sole financial responsibility of the artist.

Sharing a booth will be allowed. If sharing a booth, fill out one application for the booth. Enter each participant's name on the application.

All trash must be removed by the artist at the end of the festival. Containers will be made available. Artists will be responsible for leaving their area clean.

Electricity will not be provided.
