Work Permits: Link

The link above has a handbook from the Department of Education and an application from the Division of Labor Standards Enforcement. This form is submitted by the parent to the Office Staff who consult the Principal.

Students who are truant (poor attendance patterns) or are not keeping up with academic standards will not be approved for a work permit. The Division of Labor Standards Enforcement (DLSE) issues all entertainment industry permits. Inquiring parents or employers must be referred to the nearest DLSE office.

Independent Study - The Rules

Independent Study is appropriate for Emergencies, catastrophic family situations, legal/government situations, severe health or other special circumstances. Independent Study is NOT for extending the length of school holidays, vacations or visiting family or friends.

The school must be informed in advance (two weeks / we realize this isn't always possible in an Emergency). A contract needs to be filled out and signed by the parent, teacher and Principal. If work is not turned in or is not complete, partial credit or no credit may be given.

Safe Arrival and Departure Plan Update

Please refrain from using your cell phone in the parking lot. The area along the front of the school (yellow curb) is reserved for parents/drivers who drive in to quickly drop-off or pick-up their children, so please do not leave your vehicle parked there. Once you have dropped off your child, merge left and depart the drop-off line. Children should exit from the right side of the vehicle. Abandoned vehicles create an unsafe environment. Thanks for your cooperation.

There is no valet at Grayfox so parents must exit their vehicle and greet their child at the gate.

At the Fernhill gate we are no longer using the A-Z system due to children walking unsafely through traffic. Rather, we are now keeping the children safe by the office and releasing them as we see you pull up. You can help by placing your child's name placard on your dashboard. Some parents have nannies and various automobiles, or tinted windows so we just know who you are or whom you are picking up until you are very close to us. A placard helps speed things up for busy parents and helps staff react with efficiency. Your help is appreciated by everyone.
