# SY25 Brookhaven Elementary School School Improvement Goals

## **Literacy SMARTIE Goals**

School Literacy Goal (This represents the overall **student achievement** of an underserved focus group(s). Achieving this goal will be essential in order to accomplish the District goal for <u>all</u> students, and address the root cause of inequity at the school level):

By the end of SY25 at least 69% of all K-2 students will meet the academic milestone on the spring DIBELS composite score (from 64% to 69%).

By the end of SY25 at least 59% of all 3-5 students will meet the academic milestone on the spring MAP-R assessment (from 54% to 59%).

#### Math SMARTIE Goals

School Math Goal (This represents the overall **student achievement** of an underserved focus group(s). Achieving this goal will be essential in order to accomplish the District goal for <u>all</u> students, and address the root cause of inequity at the school level):

By the end of the 2025 school year, at least 51% of all students will meet the Spring MAP (MAP-P for K-2; MAP-M for 3-5) with a 3 or higher. This would be a 5% increase in proficiency from the 2024 school year.

# **Culture/Climate SMARTIE Goals**

By the end of SY25, 85% of all students will agree or strongly agree that they belong at Brookhaven and 93% of all students will agree or strongly agree that they have a teacher and/or other student at Brookhaven that they can count on to help them, no matter what, as reported on our School Survey data.

### **Well-Being SMARTIE Goals**

Brookhaven will reduce chronic absenteeism **in grades K-5 (17.9%) by 8%** over the course of three years (**1/3** a year), by developing a step by step plan to increase communication between teachers & staff and students & their families when students are approaching chronic absenteeism to increase awareness of the negative academic effects on students who are chronically absent. Total progress will be measured at the end of each school year by calculating the chronic absenteeism rate, with the goal of it decreasing by **1/3** each year. This progress will also be tracked throughout the year using the structure that will be put into place.
