
Initial Login Instructions

All secondary parents/guardians should have received an email in September containing Naviance account information. If you cannot locate the email, please contact your student's school counselor for assistance.


Step 1 - Use the school specific link to visit your school's Naviance site.

COMMUNICATION REGARDING THE FOUR-YEAR PLAN

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Your student's counselor has reviewed their Four-Year Plan. The next step is to log in to Naviance and select "Approve" to confirm that you have reviewed the plan.

Please keep the following in mind as you review:

- The goal is to outline all four years; however, some students found it challenging to make decisions for future years, and that is okay.
- What is most important right now is that all courses listed in the 10th-grade column are complete, as these will be used to generate course requests for next year.
- Course selections are not final. **There will be a change window via Google Form from mid-February through the final change deadline of March 12, 4p.**
- You may notice that some courses appear to repeat within a column. This is a known Naviance glitch—no action is needed. Counselors will clean this up when course requests are loaded into Home Access Center (HAC).
- **Please select "Approve" even if you anticipate requesting changes later.** This approval simply acknowledges that you have reviewed the plan and allows us to move forward with scheduling.
- Viper Night (January 22, 5 p.m.) will be a wonderful night for students to further explore their elective options before finalizing their choices.
