IN YOUR CHAPTER

1. Talk with your chapter members about *their* ideas for growing your membership or seeding new chapters.
2. Reach out to inactive members to let them know you miss them and invite them to come back. Order “We Miss You” postcards [HERE](#) and find a sample email [HERE](#).
3. Designate a chapter meeting as a “Bring a Friend” event -- see [sample email](#) for members to invite people.
4. Follow up on inquiries that come from the Rise website -- see [tips for welcoming potential new people](#).
5. Post on your social media – images and templates are [here](#). Just copy and paste!
6. Solicit members to do outreach in your local community – see ideas and tools below.
7. Have a member who is relocating? Encourage them to start a chapter at their new location!
8. Reach out to out-of-town friends or family members and offer to coach them through starting a chapter in their own community. [See more tips for seeding new chapters here](#).

IN YOUR COMMUNITY

1. Seek opportunities to talk to local groups (i.e. service or women’s clubs), your place of worship, or your workplace. See PPT presentation resources [HERE](#).
2. Distribute Rise brochures to appropriate locations in your community (i.e. local volunteer bureau, Welcome Wagon, etc.). Order brochures [HERE](#), and we’ll send them to you for free!
3. Participate in a local event with a Rise table. Banners and display materials can be ordered [HERE](#).
