

RNZCUC pre-approved university papers

Below are some specific papers that are accepted, and some broad categories of papers, qualifications and courses from universities and medical Colleges that may be accepted. Registrars are encouraged to submit suggestions for courses of study for consideration.

Before committing to any university paper or equivalent, confirm with the Education Committee or Director of Clinical Training that it is acceptable.

Reimbursement of fees paid for funded registrars is limited by the amounts allowed by workforce planning and funding (WPF – they replaced HWNZ). Check with the training programme coordinator if this is an important consideration.
