

Welcome to this Doc! This Doc has Clip Studio Paint Brushes I use that I'm sharing with you. The brushes will have links to them in this doc and will go row by row (Sketching, Pens + Extras, Brush (as in paint brush), Airbrush, Effects, Erasers and Blenders).

Sketch:

- **SU Cream Pencil** <https://assets.clip-studio.com/en-us/detail?id=1761353>
- I use this brush for sketch / lineart.
- **Thick Pen** <https://assets.clip-studio.com/en-us/detail?id=2099271>
- I use this as a hair sketching brush - I put down the basic shapes with this brush and use SU Cream Pencil to trace over it and add more detail on another layer.

- I don't use this as much but it makes base coloring a piece so much easier.

- I use this brush when I'm doing Chibi Art.

- I don't use this as much anymore but I used it for coloring in big spaces because Clip Studio Paint lags a lot for me.

Pens + Extras:

- **G-Pen** - I use the basic G-Pen in Clip Studio Paint when I want to do Lineart.

- Same as the G-Pen, for lineart. This brush reminds me of the Dry Ink Brush in Procreate, which I adore.

- I use this for sketching Eyelashes before I use either SU Cream Pencil or G-Pen to trace them and fill them in.

Brush:

- I use this to do all of my coloring and shading (Though I use a blender to blend it out which you'll see later in this Document).
- **The brush also lazy to do a single thickness paint even watercolor main line.**

Airbrush:

Soft - I use the basic Soft airbrush provided by Clip Studio Paint.

Effects:

Effects: I only use the Effects Provided by Clip Studio Paint.

Background: I only use the Background Material Provided by Clip Studio Paint.

Clothing: I only use the Clothing Material Provided by Clip Studio Paint.

Sparkly Effects:

- **Sparkle** - I use the Sparkle Effect Provided by Clip Studio Paint.

Erasers:

Hard - I use the Hard Brush that's provided by Clip Studio Paint.

Blenders:

Blend - I use the Blend Brush that is in the default Clip Studio Paint Program.

Blur - I use the Blur Brush that is in the default Clip Studio Paint Program.
