- ✓ Attention to Safety Climbing is dangerous, always use redundant safety checks with your partner and do not succumb to complacency! Climbing gyms are not amusement park rides where everything is taken care of for you. Rather, indoor climbing simulates the outdoor environmentalwhere YOU must manage the risks and the risks for any minors under your supervision.
- ✓ Attention to Self Be preparedphysically and mentally for practices and competitions. This includes being vigilant and reliable while belaying.
 - Water/hydration, gear, appropriate athletic attire, and a positive attitude are allcritically important.
- ✓ Respect—Have fun, but be mindful and considerate of other climbers, teams, and patrons at the gym.
- ✓ Attendance Practices and competitions run smoother when everyone shows up prepared and on time.
- ✔ Progression— Not everyone will climb like a nimble mountain goat all the time, but we all can improve throughout the season in our own way. Focus on your objective and have fun working through the process!

Brief overview of climbing as a competitive sport:

- Climbing route difficulty ratings ("Yosemite Decimal System" "YDS"):
 - \circ Easier (5.0 5.6),
 - Moderate (5.7 5.9),
 - Difficult (5.10 5.11)
 - Very Difficult (5.12 5.13)
 - Extremely Difficult (5.13+ & up)
- ClimberScore = aggregatepoint value of the four (4) most difficult climbs completed in competition w/o hanging/falling off the wall ("clean")
- Team Score = combined total of the top five (5) climber's scores from eachteam
- Preparedness + Adaptability are the keys to a successful competition, no matter what level you're at!
