## **CHAMPS FAQs**

Question:	What incentive is being offered for my attendance?
Answer:	Professional staff will be able to receive <b>14</b> of their PDCE credits for the 24-25 SY by attending CHAMPS training in June and July, 2024.
Question:	Do I have to attend the training dates consecutively?
Answer:	Yes. Registrants must attend 2 days of training consecutively.
Question:	If I absolutely cannot attend either of the 5 summer sessions offered, when else can I receive CHAMPS training?
Answer:	Alternate CHAMPS training dates will be provided during the 24-25 school year. These training sessions may take place on Saturdays or after school. Registrants must attend the full series selected, to receive credit. Alternate dates will be communicated in August.
Question:	What if I received CHAMPS training in another school district? Do I still have to attend?
Answer:	If you have received training from <b>Safe &amp; Civil Schools</b> within the last 2 years, you may provide proof of training through Edugence, however <b>you will not receive PDCE credit</b> . View this <u>video</u> for instructions on uploading proof of attendance for external professional development and training to the Edugence platform.
Question:	Do clerks and front office staff have to attend CHAMPS?
Answer:	No. Office staff are not required to attend CHAMPS.
Question:	Can a high school teacher or aide attend CHAMPS training?
Answer:	The summer training dates are reserved for elementary, intermediate and middle school campuses. However, high school teachers/aides may attend any of the training provided during the school year.
Question:	If aides attend this training, will they receive PED credit?
Answer:	Summer training is highly encouraged, and aides will receive PED credit for attending.
Question:	I am a counselor or Instructional Support Specialist and would like to attend CHAMPS training. Can I sign up to come?
Answers:	Yes. Support Staff are not required to attend CHAMPS training but are welcome!
Question:	I worked on a Duncanville ISD elementary campus last school year and went through CHAMPS training. Do I have to attend again?
Answer:	<b>No.</b> If you received CHAMPS training through Duncanville ISD for the 23-24 SY, you have already completed your CHAMPS requirement.

Question:	I didn't get all my PDCE or PED hours this year (23-24) and I see there is a CHAMPS training on May 29th and 30th. Can I attend that?
Answer:	<b>Yes.</b> If you owe time on May 29th and 30th, you may attend CHAMPS training for the 24-25 SY on those dates. Please keep in mind that attending in May will grant you PDCE/PED credits for the 23-24 SY only; but the training you receive will prepare you for the 24-25 SY.
