Second grade students have been introduced to the following concepts and skills from April 1, 2025 through June 16, 2025. The report card will indicate how your child is progressing towards the grade level standards. Comments provided will highlight your child's strengths, areas for growth, as well as suggestions for ways in which to support your child's learning.

PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT

Respect: Respects others both in school and online and takes care of materials.

Responsibility: Regulates behavior, accepts responsibility for choices, and completes tasks.

Ready to Learn: Perseveres, uses time constructively, and responds effectively to directions.

MATHEMATICS

- Solves addition and subtraction story problems to 100
- Demonstrates fluency with addition up to 20
- Demonstrates fluency with subtraction up to 20
- Understands that three-digit numbers represent amounts of hundreds, tens, and ones
- Skip counts by 5s, 10s, and 100s to 1,000
- Reads & writes 3-digit numbers using numerals, words, & expanded notation
- Uses symbols $<$, $=$, $>$ to compare two numbers
- Adds and subtracts three-digit numbers accurately, efficiently, & explains strategies
- Mentally adds or subtracts 10 and 100 to or from numbers up to 1,000
- Solves money problems with dollar bills, quarters, dimes, nickels, and pennies
- Recognizes 2D & 3D shapes (triangles, rectangles, pentagons, hexagons, & cubes)

SCIENCE

- Classify & test materials based on properties.
- Explain how an object has the same weight when it's broken down as it does when it is whole.
- Explain how some states of change are reversible while others are irreversible.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

Reading:

- Reads literature and informational text
- Retells important information and demonstrates understanding using key details in the text
- Uses evidence from the text to predict and infer
- Interprets author's craft and text structures
- Knows and applies grade level phonics and word analysis skills
- Reads orally with accuracy, appropriate rate, and expression to support comprehension

Writing:

- Writes a lead to introduce a topic and wraps up the piece with an ending
- Includes different parts and makes connections using transition words
- Uses words and details appropriate to the writing task
- Applies grade level spelling, punctuation, and capitalization
