Theoneste Uwayezu, who leads a company called ICT For All in All, located at Remera in Kigali city, highlights that they found it essential in today's world to help every person in need of training studying the English language. It is considered a commercial language. He added that they support (teach English to) students who are preparing to sit for national exams, traders, leaders, and other diverse people; that in four months, a person can speak perfect English. More also a person is confident enough to stand in public and talk about something.

Uwayezu said that they have specialized (experienced) teachers plus foreigners when it comes to debates. These people are the ones who support those in training to gain more knowledge in the English language for a brief period. ICT For All in All focuses more on public speaking, that "we focus more on speaking (speaking the language) and it is better to train yourself when interacting with others for feedback and development through learning from them."

He highlighted that 80% of their training focuses on public speaking, while other parts come as surplus. 70-80% is speaking, and an additional 30% holds the remaining parts of the English language.

At ICT For All in All support researchers to do research and to explain well to people about the research; they also train people about project management, either the projects that require funds and donations or any other type of projects that require loans and sponsorship. Uwayezu mentioned that "Language (English) is the first thing/priority. What is more, we have an excellent service of project management, whether projects that require loans or the regular project that requires personal investments.

To avoid a pandemic Corona Virus and help the learners study in a safe and favorable climate, we allow ten people in every class. On the working days, only one day is when they come to the site while they study both Saturday and Sunday afternoon on weekends.

Uwayezu gave an example saying that a person is taught according to his/her daily career-related like a trader could go to purchase goods from Dubai without hiring an interpreter.

Uwayezu notifies that they started providing such training starting from young children after expanding to older adults. He mentioned that "we started helping young children about science using technology (digitalization) and still now we help young especially those who prepare themselves to sit for national exams. Additionally, we help them to develop their level of success, adding technology and career guidance. We also expanded the program to adults by assisting different people to learn about projects, building and analyzing these projects as commercial projects, helping young children research, and publishing the research. However, we realized that a person who publishes his/her research becomes a problem due to a language problem.

Uwayezu Theoneste continued by saying that "we came to realize that there is a problem in speaking and usage of English. That is why we initiated this program of English for Business and Leaders". We teach people to speak English, especially 70-80 percent; we develop his/her

English-speaking level for that trader who purchases goods from Dubai, China, United States of America can translate for him/her without hiring a translator.

In conclusion, He mentioned why they focus more on the English language because it is considered a commercial language and is used everywhere around the world. That "speaking on the side of a person who provides a service and speaks English, it will be easier to communicate with a person in need of the service. Also, the English language is necessary for the leader to pitch what is done in his/her community. This is why we decided to bring about the idea at the table, it takes only four months to be able to speak good English, and a person can travel all around the world when speaking and writing good English.

Uwayezu Theoneste says that this school started in 2017, and more than 100 people have acquired knowledge from this class. Umuhire Joyce is one of the students who studied at "ICT For All in All" highlighted that she benefited from many things because she had English speaking and listening problems before joining this class. Umuhire Joyce is pleased now because this problem is solved because she managed to succeed in the exam that permits people to study abroad. She encouraged people to continually be updated and go according to what the world requires, such as technology and the English language.
