- Jared:

- Spoke on Incorporation of the chapter, its importance in terms of being able to better utilize dues we are receiving from National.
- WSDSA currently has the PEX card, ~\$1400 on it.

- o Need to see cost comparison with Johanna's vista-print connections and a local printer.
- o Brought up the need for a better system for keeping our signs and storage somewhere.
- o Johanna also mentioned a potential discount for t-shirts
- Carlos: Boycotts:
  - Huelga Para La Dignidad Boycott of grocers who use Pilgrims Pride chicken due to company's long standing abuse of undocumented labor and donations to right wing campaigns.




# LAND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT STATEMENT

"Every part of this soil is sacred in the estimation of my people.

Every hillside, every valley, every plain and grove, has been hallowed by some sad or happy event in days long vanished."

Chief Seattle 1854

We would like to begin by acknowledging that the land on which we gather is within the ancestral territory of the suqwabš "People of Clear Salt Water" (Suquamish People). Expert fisherman, canoe builders and basket weavers, the suqwabš live in harmony with the lands and waterways along Washington's Central Salish Sea as they have for thousands of years. Here, the suqwabš live and protect the land and waters of their ancestors for future generations as promised by the Point Elliot Treaty of 1855.
