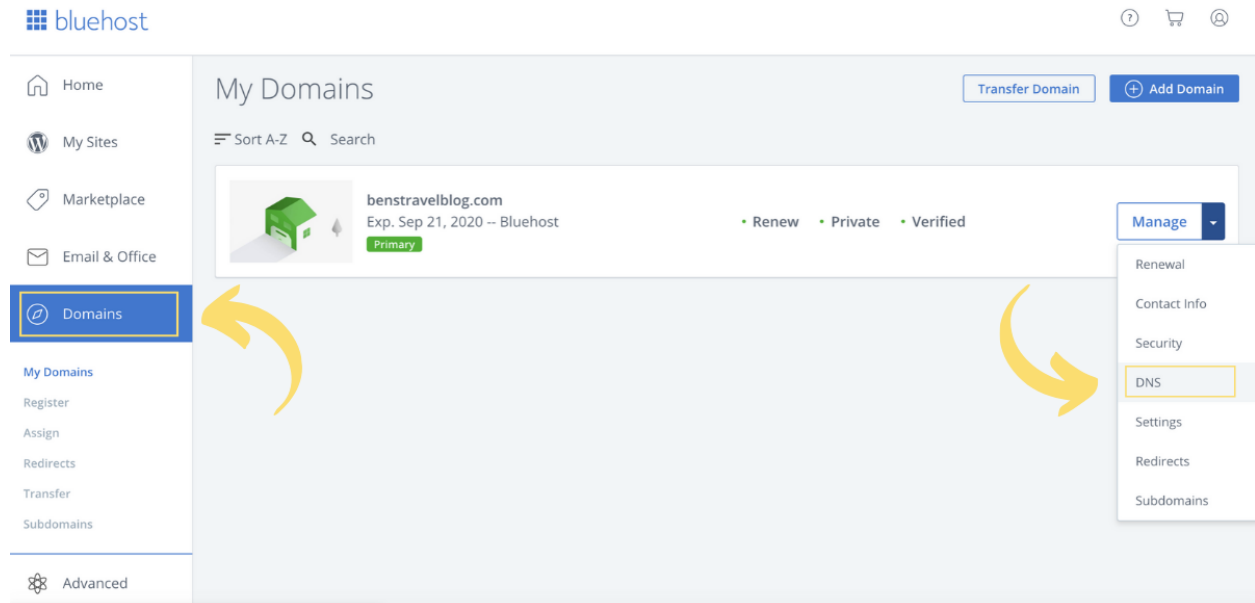
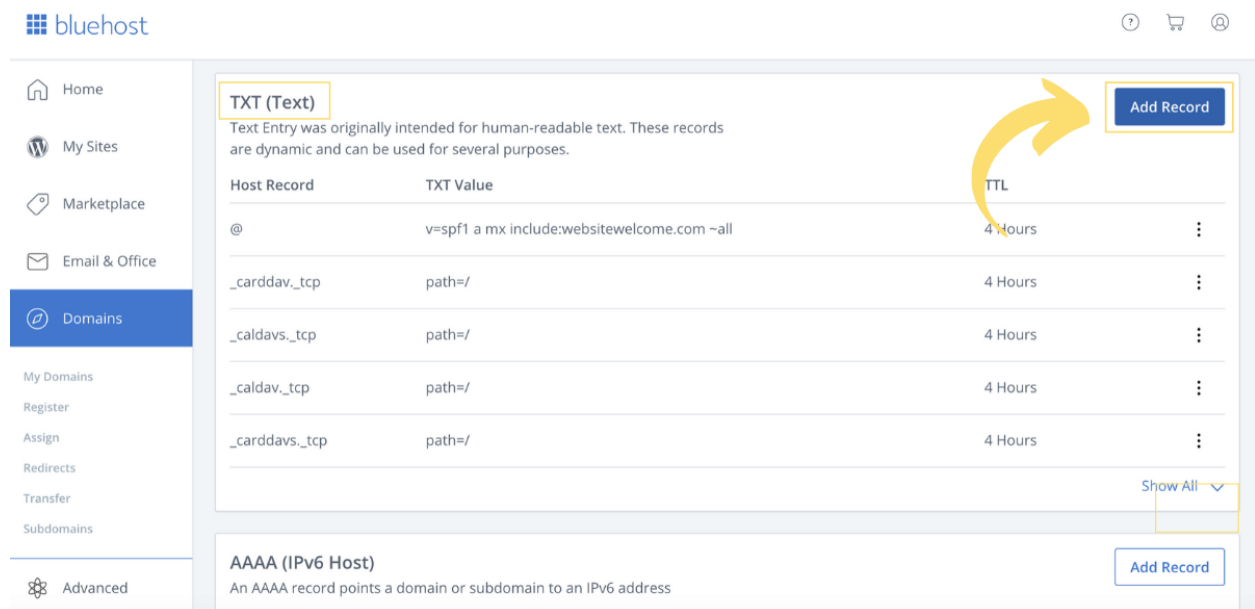


1. Log into your Bluehost account.
2. Click on Domains>Manage>DNS



3. Scroll down to the TXT Records section and click the Add Record button.



4. Enter the following in the three fields provided and click the Save button.

Host Record: @

TXT Value: Paste the TXT record you just copied from Search Console.

TTL: Leave at 4 Hours (min)
