Welcome to your **NCCP Introduction to Competition Canoe Kayak Coach** course!

This training opportunity is designed for coaches who are teaching paddling skills to paddlers along the competition pathway, as well as fundamental skill development. The Competition Introduction context focuses on coaching within the **Fundamentals, Training to Train, and Active for Life** stages of Long-Term Athlete Development.

Coach candidates will begin their learning experience with a **pre-course task**, available in Google Classroom. This assignment must be submitted prior to **May 23, 2026**.

In-Person Component

The in-person sessions will take place on:

- **Saturday, May 23, 2026** (9:00 AM – 5:00 PM)
- **Sunday, May 24, 2026** (9:00 AM – 5:00 PM)

This NCCP Learning Facilitator-led course is highly interactive and will include:

- Group discussions, collaborative work, technical skill development
- Online activities and assignments completed through Google Classroom

Coaches are required to bring a laptop or device capable of completing online assignments.

If you experience difficulty accessing Google Classroom, you may need to use or create a Gmail account. The Google Classroom link will be included in your registration confirmation email on **May 20, 2026**.

Certification Process

Following the in-person workshop, coach candidates will enter the second stage of certification, which includes:

- Completing practical coaching tasks within their home club environment
- Completing the required NCCP Multi-Sport Modules (listed below)



The final stage of certification involves a **Practical Evaluation**.

Prior to the Practical Evaluation, coaches must complete and submit their **Coach Portfolio**, which includes:

- Emergency Action Plan (EAP)
- Practice Plan
- Weekly Training Plan

Additional Modules Required for Certification

The following NCCP Multi-Sport modules must be completed:

- **NCCP Planning a Practice** (includes the free Emergency Action Plan eLearning activity)
- **NCCP Making Ethical Decisions** (includes the free EAP module)
- **NCCP Teaching & Learning**
- **NCCP Sport Nutrition**
- **NCCP Safe Sport**
