



## Senior SPRING 2024 Exam Exemption Guidelines 2023-24

A qualifying senior will be eligible to be exempt from their final exam in the spring of 2024 for each class in which they meet the following guidelines:

1. The student must earn ONE College and Career Readiness Indicator by May 1, 2024. Qualifying College and Career Indicators (CCRI) include:
  - a. A **Benchmark Score** on one or more sections of the **ACT test**.
    - i. English--18
    - ii. Math--22
    - iii. Reading--22
    - iv. Science--23
  - b. **Silver Level Mastery** on the **ACT WorkKeys test**.
  - c. A **Qualifying Score** of 3 or higher on an **AP Exam**.
  - d. A **C or higher** in at least **3 CTE-approved electives** in the same career pathway.
  - e. A **Qualifying Score** on the **certification exam** within your career pathway.
  - f. A **C or higher** in any **Dual Enrollment Course**.
  - g. **Documentation of Enlistment** into one of the **branches of the military**.
2. The student may have **NO MORE THAN 2 unexcused absences** in the Spring semester (January 3 - May 10, 2024). Note: Attending Saturday School allows makeup work to be counted but does not remove unexcused absences.
3. The student may have **NO MORE THAN 5 unexcused tardies** (cumulative) in the Spring semester (January 3 - May 10, 2024). Note: Attending Saturday School allows makeup work to be counted but does not remove unexcused check-ins.
4. The student must earn a **minimum semester average of 80%** in the course by Monday, May 13, 2024.
5. Students enrolled in **AP or Dual Enrollment classes** will not be exempt from the AP exam or the semester exam of the college in which he/she is enrolled.
6. The principal of Spain Park High School, or her administrative designee, will have the final authority in all decisions involving senior exam exemption privilege.
