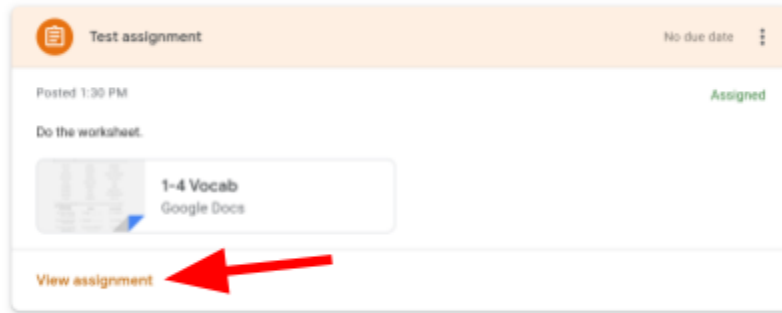
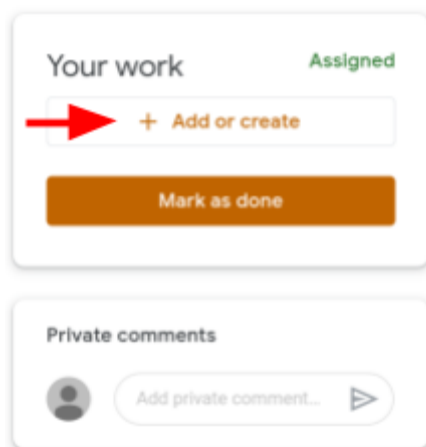


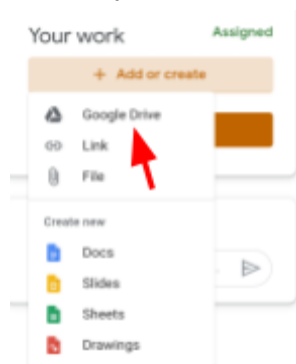
In the assignment student will need to click on View assignment:

They will then find the picture and click insert. They will need to have google drive on their phone and share the photo to their google drive. If they don't know how to do this, I added instructions for how to do that below.

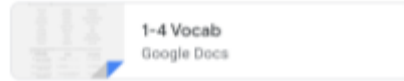

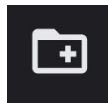

How to upload photos from your phone

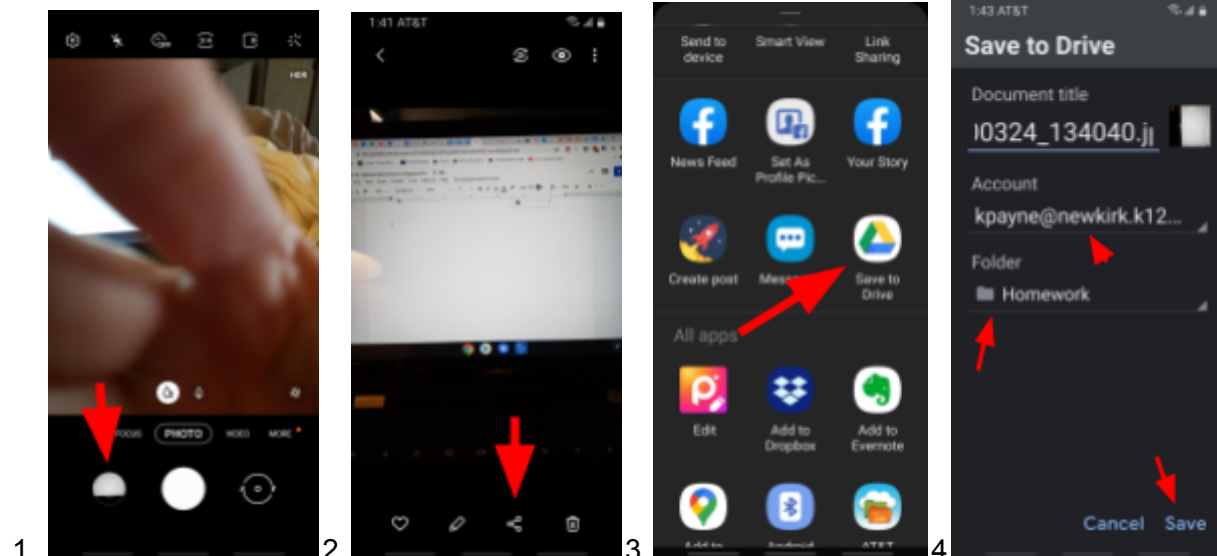
Android:

Go to play store and search for and download the google drive app. Click on the app and set up your school google account.

1. Take the picture, click on the icon in the lower right to go to gallery.
2. Click on the share icon at the bottom of the picture.
3. Click on Save to Drive. You may have to scroll down a ways to find it.
4. Make sure you are on your school account. Click on the folder, and if you don't already have



one click the add folder icon: and create a folder called homework, or hw pics. Then click save.



Iphone:

1. Start by downloading the Google Drive app on your iPhone, if you haven't already.
2. Open the Google Drive app.
3. In the bottom right corner, you'll see a multicolored "+" icon. Tap it.
4. Tap "Upload," then "Photos and Videos." Make sure your image file is an uploadable format. Image types supported by Google are .JPEG, .PNG, .GIF, .BMP, .TIFF and .SVG.
5. Go into your iPhone's Albums and select the photos you'd like to add to Google Drive.
